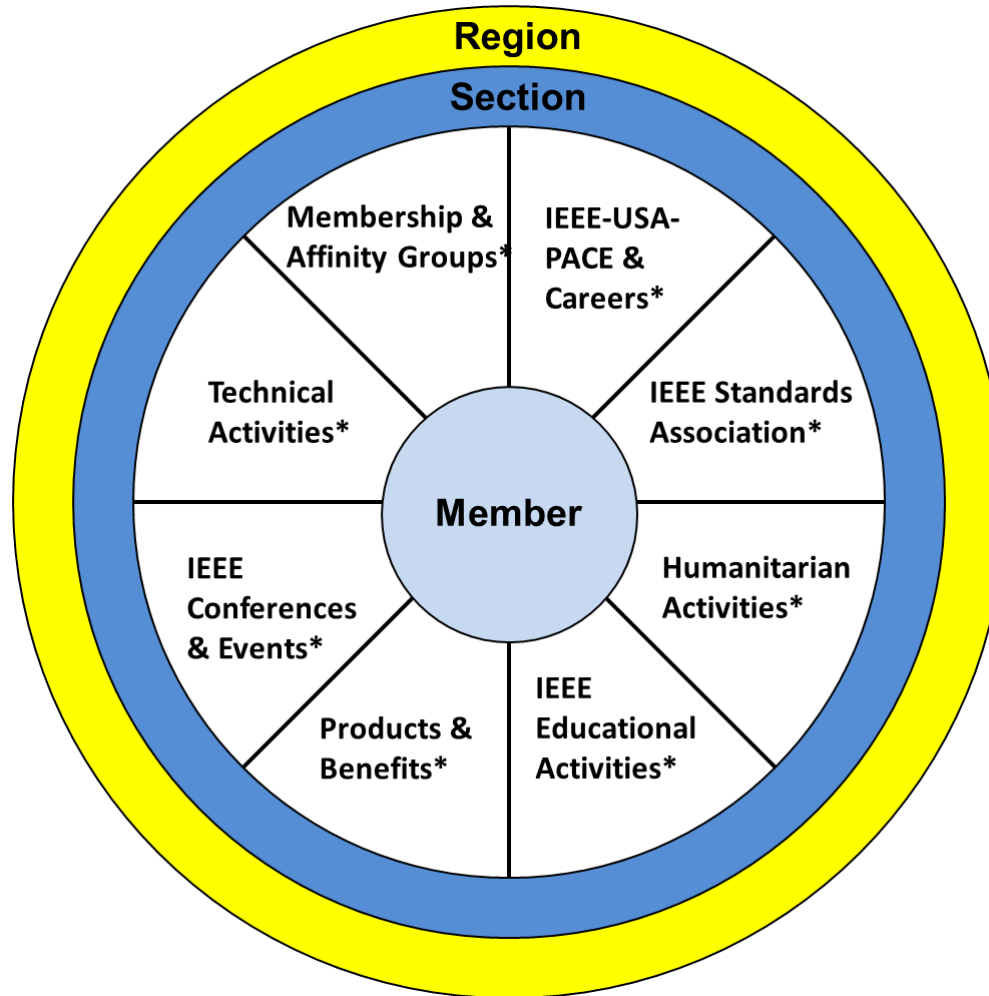

Responsibilities

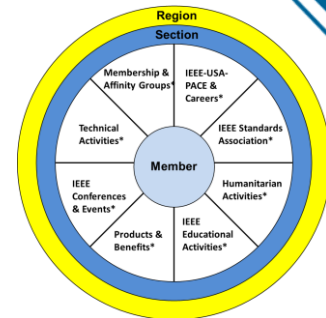

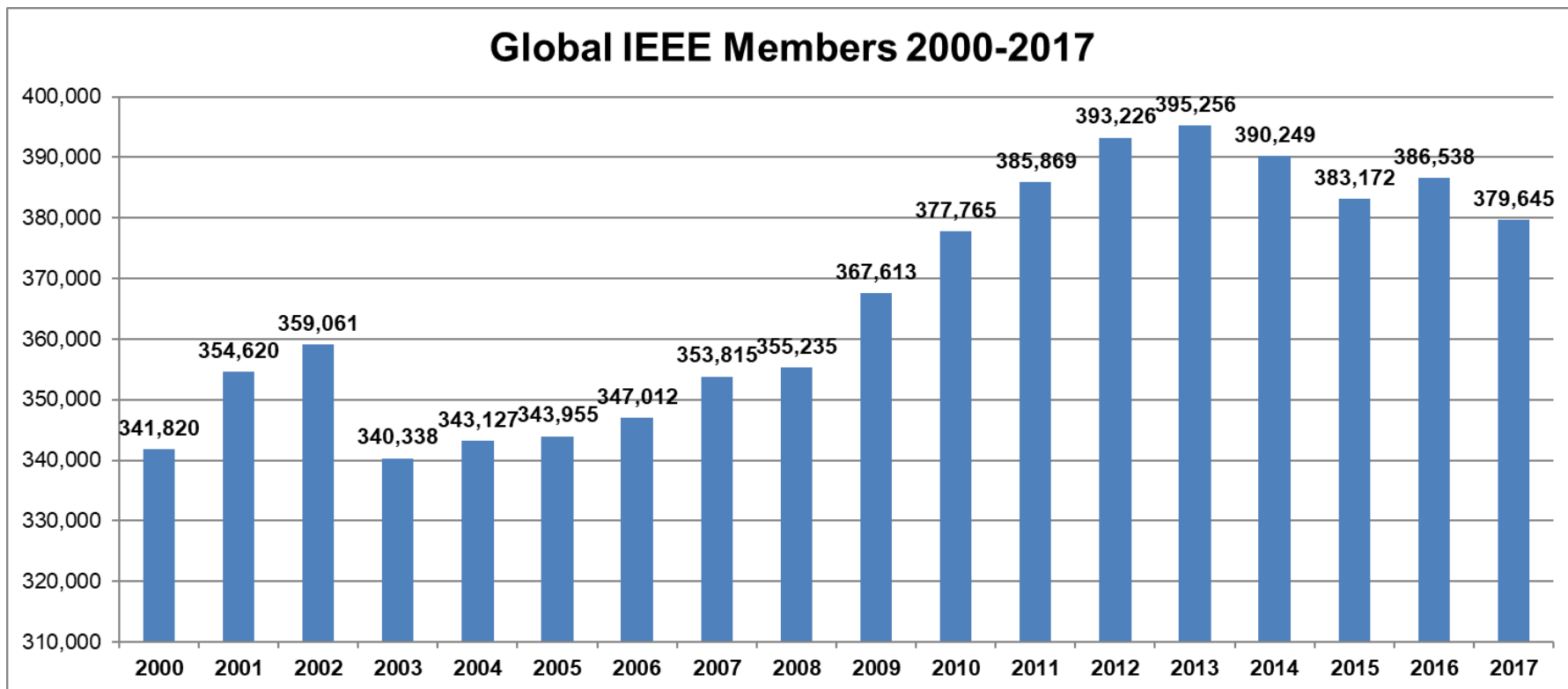

Elevator Pitch Challenge

Issue: Do you know what your members **AND** non-members value?

- ▶ Everyone's definition is different
- ▶ Not all benefits are relevant to every Section or Member

Solution: The "Elevator Pitch" should be a conversation

- ▶ Every volunteer should have an answer to:
 - **WHY** they are a member/volunteer?
 - **What** do they value from membership?
- ▶ Discuss what the prospect/member is interested in
 - Offer to help them find the solution

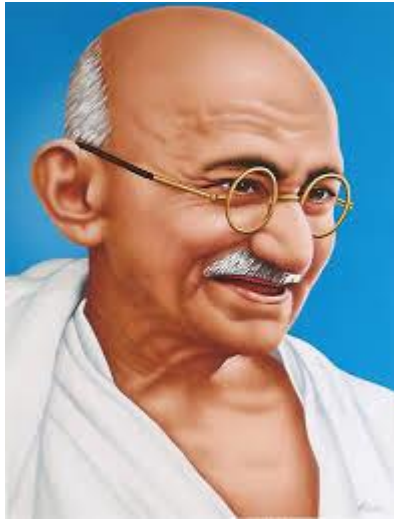
