

IEEE Membership Development Cycle





The Current State of Region 3 Student Membership

- ▶ Total Number of Student members: 4,391*
 - Approx. +8.0% over 2017
- Student Branch Data
 - Potential Student Branches: ~143**
 - Active Student Branches: 92
 - 3 do not have volunteers reported
 - Student Branch Chapters & Affinity Groups: 81
 - 9 do not have volunteers reported
- Student Volunteer Data (excluding Counselors)^
 - Branches with potentially outdated volunteers: 32
 - Branch Chapters with potentially outdated volunteers: 15

IEEE Policy Changes for Student Branches

Highlights of the MGA Board-Approved Changes

- Student Branches are now officially under the local Sections' organizational structure
 - Similar to local chapters and affinity groups.
- ► To approve a new Student Branch, approval is required from
 - The Region Director
 - The Region Student Activities Coordinator
 - *NEW* The Section Chair
- Rebates will be based on students who attend schools within the Section
- For Student Branch reporting and rebates:
 - All individual activities/events still need to be reported via vTools Events
 - Deadline for 2018 rebate: 1 November 2018
 - *NEW* Student Branch Annual plan must be reported
 - Launch date: November 2018
 - Via the Student Branch Reporting Tool
 - Must be reported by 1 February 2019 to be eligible for rebates

IEEE Member and Geographic Activities

Operations Manual 2018

IEEE MGA 445 Hoes Lane Piscataway, NJ 08854, USA

This document incorporates changes to the MGA Operations Manual approved by the IEEE MGA Board through 23 June 2018.

- ► Section 9.4.F.1 The Section Student Representative is exempt from the member grade requirement
 - They must still be an Active member
- ▶ Section 9.4.D.3 Recommends the Section ExCom select:
 - A Section Student Activities Chair (SSAC)
 - Section Student Representative (SSR)
 - Both should be voting members of the Section ExCom.
- Operations Manual Section 9.7.H Details the Student branch Reporting and Funds changes
 - Reporting timeline
 - Number of activities
 - Annual plan v. annual report
 - Branch Counselor no longer required to endorse.

How Can Sections Support the Branches

Engage Your Student Branches ASAP

- Step 1: Make sure your Section has Student representation on your ExCom
 - Identify your:
 - Section Student Activities Chair (SSAC)
 - Section Student Representative (SSR)
 - Suggest forming a committee
 - Ask your active members if they would like to help
- Step 2: Have your new Student representatives reach out to current student branches
 - Make sure their Officer Reporting is up-to-date
 - Review the Student Branch reporting requirements
 - Log all activities in <u>vTools Events</u>
 - Deadline for 2018 rebate: 1 November 2018.
 - The new Annual Plan requirement starts November 1
 - Submit via <u>vTools Student Branch Reporting</u>
 - Needed to receive Student Branch Rebate


Identifying Student Volunteers






Student Branch Membership Report




Student Branch Report
