- 1) Director Vaughn began the meeting at 8:05pm.
- 2) The meeting agenda was approved.
- 3) The consent agenda, consisting of the minutes from the 28 January 2019 ExCom Meeting and reports listed in the information agenda, was approved.
- 4) Officer Reports
  - a) Director Report
    - i) Director Vaughn briefly discussed IEEE Dataport, a data service provided for researchers.
    - ii) Director Vaughn expressed his appreciation to all those volunteers who have worked in preparation for SoutheastCon 2019, and discussed how our conference is held in high esteem across IEEE, including the IEEE leadership.
  - b) Director-Elect Report
    - i) Director-Elect Gostin has contacted all Section Chairs and Area Chairs to inform them of what to expect at SoutheastCon 2019. She discussed the two-track format of the Region meetings on Friday and Saturday of the conference, and reminded Section Chairs of the time limitations for the Section reports at the Region Meeting.

    - i) Secretary Donohoe has posted all submitted reports to the meeting website, and encouraged those with other reports to submit them for posting after the meeting.
    - ii) Sections were again reminded to update their officer information on vTools including start/end dates for each officer term.

    - i) Some simple editorial changes to the Region 3 travel policy have been made on the Region 3 website.
    - ii) Treasurer Pigg is compiling a list of all volunteers who are traveling to SoutheastCon and needs to have all volunteers to submit the information requested.
    - iii) Treasurer Pigg provided details on the Region 3 budget report year to date.
  - e) Past Director Report
    - i) Past Director Conrad discussed the availability of volunteer positions at the Region level and at the MGA level.
- 5) Action Agenda
  - a) Motion from the Region 3 Conferences Committee regarding the SoutheastCon 2022 site
    - i) The Conference Committee moves that the Region 3 EXCOM approve the proposal from the Mobile Section to host SoutheastCon 2022 in Mobile, Alabama. The primary volunteer

support will come from the University of South Alabama. The dates of the conference are March 30 – April 3 and the venue is the Renaissance Mobile Riverview Plaza Hotel. The EXCOM voted unanimously to place this recommendation before the Region Committee at SoutheastCon 2019 for approval.
