Over the past few years I have been trying to retool the Conferences Committee to allow us to focus more on supporting the growth of conferences within our Sections instead of having SoutheastCon consume the majority of the committee's effort. To support this model, we have created a Region Level SoutheastCon Subcommittee that will handle the year-to-year parts of the conference and bring some continuity to the conference.
