I have been busy working with the N&A Committee to fill the Region positions for 2020. Thank you to those of you who have volunteered to serve. I greatly appreciate your willingness to share your talents and your time in service to the members of Region 3!

In 2020, our Region Committee meeting at SoutheastCon will be shortened (no need to arrive Thurs night), so that we can also have a Region Committee meeting at Sections Congress in Ottawa Canada. Many of our Sections are already discussing and planning for Sections Congress 2020, which will be held Aug 21-23, 2020, in Ottawa Canada at the Shaw Centre – the theme is "Leading our Global Technical Community". Our Region Committee meeting will be on Friday morning. Sections Congress officially begins Friday evening, and ends on Sunday.
