Issues requiring action by the Region 3 Committee or ExCom

- E-Notice → Unsure of the level of penetration to membership through the use of e-notice. We have anecdotal evidence that our emails are not reaching our membership.
 Are there e-mail tracking metrics so we can validate our assumptions?
- Region reports → R3 treasurer mentioned he received a report of sections that had completed their year end financials. Is there a list of region reports and recipients that section officers should know?
- Virtual meetings → What percentage of events have shifted to virtual meetings in sections across R3?

Successes/Opportunities for Engaging the member, volunteer, non-member, public

- Section started a Health and Wellness series in 4 QTR 2019. 1st event had 18 participants, and a high non-member/public attendance. Activities will continue into 2020.
- Life member affinity group chartered in 2019. First meeting will be in 2020
- Charleston Engineering Joint Council → We have used the open engineering forum in Charleston to promote IEEE events to other engineering organizations

Notable section activities (positive and negative)

- STEM → ISC² Safe and Secure Online parents brief. Low attendance for event. Planning team identified this as a gap in STEM capabilities but we have been unable to find a venue providing a receptive audience.
- STEM → ISC² Garfield CyberSafety presentations to elementary school (https://www.iamcybersafe.org/s/garfields-cyber-safety-adventures). Section partnered with Charleston elementary school to provide cyber safety lessons to 3rd and 4th grade classes.
- Health and Wellness → Whole person approach to membership. A professional cannot contribute if they aren't healthy. Positive response to the series of events, and a way to engage medical/healthcare community in our region.
