Review - review results

1. Increase members who are engaged in any aspect of IEEE

- The focus of increasing member engagement was intended to be through new events, and through improved communications. While some new events were held, others are still on hold until groups can meet face to face again. We will continue working on these new events in 2021.
- Region 3 funding for Section Pandemic Projects was recently approved. It is not known if this resonates with sections yet.
- Senior member and Fellow Application Sessions have been held.

2. Ensure quality actionable data is provided to Region OUs

- Director-Elect worked with Area Chairs to make sure they have needed information and resources, and were encouraged to share with Sections
- SSC addressed issues such as a problem with eNotice lists
- SSC collected and distributed information from Tableau on section/chapter meeting information to OUs
- Working directly with MGA staff to improve subunit reporting including vTools
- Encouraged expanded distribution of Section Self-Evaluation Survey results
- Survey for Chapter officers being analyzed

3. Encourage and enable Region OUs to provide more engagement opportunities for their members

This year's Theme is "**making new connections**" -- with a push for every Section (and its subunits) to hold a new event (in spite of COVID-19).

- Presented intended SoutheastCon breakout sessions as webinars in June
- Held R3 Committee meeting for Section to report on their efforts in August
- Provided webinars on "The Broader IEEE" for use as Section meetings
- Established YouTube Channels for Region 3 Volunteers and Region 3 Members and filled with content from the year.

4. Assist the Sections in focused improvement

- Hosted WebEx training events throughout the year
- Sent individualized) email to each section reporting findings from OU Analytics for their section leading to some sections
 - Revising of section officer reports
 - Discussing improving their processes with SSC
- Training webinars on holding meetings, conducting votes, etc.
- Resolved eNotice not reaching all intended section members and an anomaly in how “the do not contact” process works.
- Section Pandemic Projects
- Video channels for content including training, volunteer, and member information

5. Strengthen R3 communications capability and usage

- Resumed publication of R3 Newsletters
- Working on new Region 3 Web Separate from the “governance” website
- Increased posting on Social Media
- Converted the FaceBook group page to a Public Group Page
- *The Member Communications eNotice Initiative* - events around region
- Video channels IEEE Region 3 Volunteer Resources, IEEE Region 3 Member Resources, IEEE Region 3 Young Professionals were established.
