### **Competition Prize Change**

- ► Currently some student competitions have prize money for 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> place. Once the prize money is divided between the students, it does not come out to much. After discussion with students, SAC does not believe that students compete for the goal of receiving a portion of the prize money.
