Membership Numbers

End of January 2022

- Total Membership: 421,427 members
 - Change from January 2021: 3.5% increase
- Higher Grade Membership (without GS): 285,966 members
 - Change from January 2021: 1.6% decrease
- Undergraduate Student Membership: 83,836 members
 - Change from January 2021: 23.4% increase
- Graduate Student Memberships: 51,635 members
 - Change from January 2021: 6.1% increase
