Values and Principles

- **Core principles**
 - Maintain confidentiality
 - Report Detail is non-negotiable
 - Inaccuracies are correctable
 - Processes , systems are the focus of the Audit
 - People themselves are not the focus of the Audit
- **Core Values**
 - Seek Truth avoid assumptions
 - Seek the Root Cause (within reason)
 - Anchored by IEEE and Region 3 Mission
 - Minimize Personal Bias
 - Make Fact Based Assessments

OAC Does ...

- Conduct an operational audit of one or two standing committees each year as designated by the Director as described in Section II, Policies and Procedures: Periodic Review of Region Standing Committees.
 - 1.1. The period of time to be considered in the review is the past four to six years.
 - 1.2. The OAC shall delve into the effectiveness, contributions, policies, procedures, actions, composition, budget considerations, and other related aspects of the committee being reviewed.
 - 1.3. The OAC shall provide a written report to the Delegate/Director giving the results of the operational audit of each committee.
- Conduct an operational audit of another Region 3 entity as designated by the Delegate/Director on an “as required” basis.

OAC Does Not...

- Judge the performance of people but collects data about the performance of the function.
- Make changes to the operation but makes observations and recommendations to the Region Director.

Final Report

- The final audit report that is delivered to the Delegate/Director will contain recommendations for the committee being audited.
- The committee being audited will prepare a response to the review, addressing each recommendation and indicating acceptance, modification, rejection, or need for guidance from the Region 3 Delegate/Director.
- The report and response will be archived for at least ten years.

2022 Projects

- Conduct review of the Member Communications Committee
- Formalize the operation of the OAC by creating an OAC specific Operations Manual that contains standard guidelines, templates, checklists, and outlines for performing and documenting operational audits.

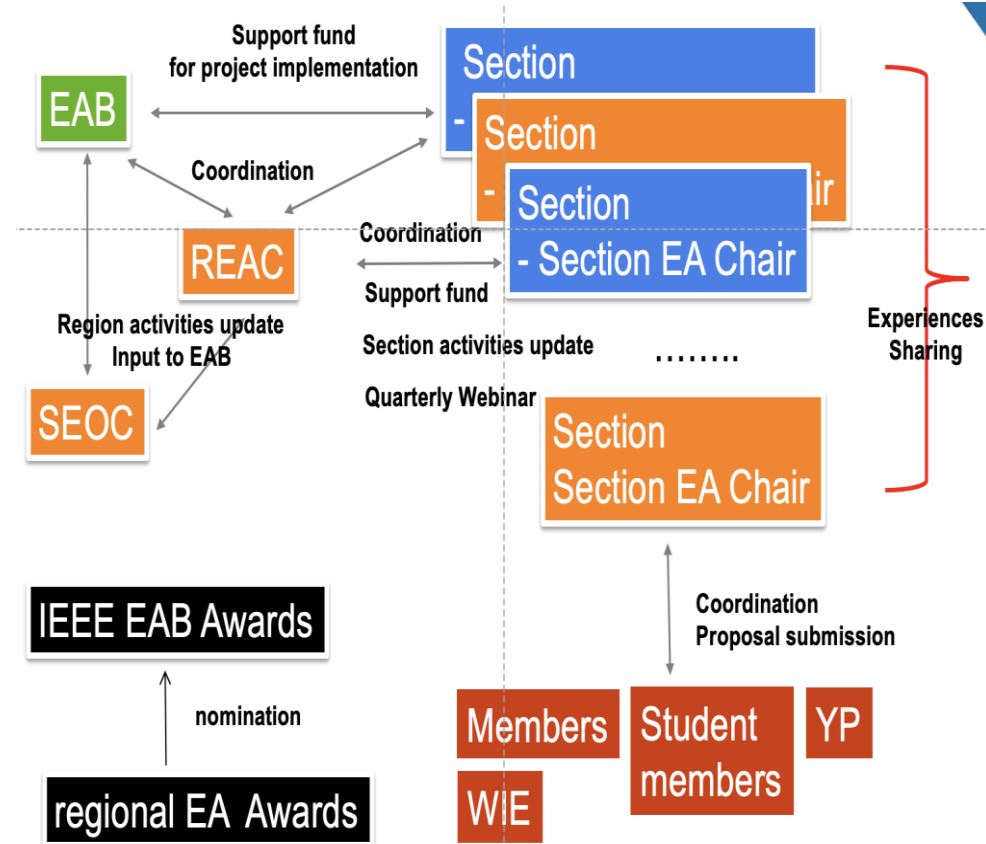
