Agenda:

- 1) Director Brunasso called the meeting to order at 8:00pm.
- 2) The meeting agenda was approved.
- 3) The consent agenda, consisting of the minutes from the 15 August 2022 ExCom Meeting and reports listed in the information agenda, was approved.
- 4) Officer Reports
 - a) Director Report
 - i) Director Brunasso announced that Sophie Muirhead, who has served as the General Counsel and Chief Compliance Officer for IEEE since 2019, is the new IEEE Executive Director and Chief Operating Officer.
 - ii) Director Brunasso thanked everyone who participated in the recent IEEE election. Tom Coughlin has been elected as the 2023 IEEE President-Elect. Keith Moore is the 2023 President-Elect for IEEE-USA. The amendment to the IEEE constitution was approved.
 - iii) Director Brunasso announced that Chan Wong (Atlanta Section) will serve as the new Region 3 Industry Relations Coordinator.
 - iv) Director Brunasso expressed happiness for all of Region 3 as Kristin Bing is now out of the hospital and at home recovering.
 - v) Director Brunasso encouraged everyone to submit nominations for our Region 3 awards. The deadline for nominations is December 1.

b) Director-Elect Report

Director-Elect Grigorian continues to support the Region 3 Director, working with the Region 3 Area Chairs and the Conference Committee. Director-Elect Grigorian will be attending IEEE Convene 2022 in Boston, MA on 27-28 October.

c) Secretary Report

Secretary Donohoe has posted all submitted reports to the meeting website. The roll call was taken for the ExCom meeting.

d) Treasurer Report

Treasurer Pennisi presented the high-level overview of the current Region 3 budget. The revenue from SoutheastCon 2022 (\$25,480.60) has been received and the conference has also repaid the loan of \$5K. SoutheastCon 2022 expense reports are almost complete and 3 Student Branches have yet to cash their travel subsidy checks. The \$5K loan for SoutheastCon 2023 has been processed.

e) Past Director Report

Past Director Gostin has recently served on several nominations and appointments committees throughout IEEE and noted a general reduction in the number of submitted nominations. She encouraged current volunteers whose terms are ending to identify others that could fill these positions, and provide them information about the positions. Past Director Gostin encouraged everyone to mark their calendars for Sections Congress 2023 (August 11-13, Ottawa, Canada).

5) Action Agenda

Approval of 2023 Region 3 Budget

Treasurer Pennisi presented details of the proposed 2023 Region 3 budget. The overall regional expense amount for 2023 is impacted by Sections Congress 2023. As typical, Region 3 plans to have a deficit budget for 2023, in the amount of approximately \$159K. This amount was approved by the Region 3 Finance Committee considering the \$246.5K of total region surplus for the years of 2020 and 2021. The income projection for 2023 is conservative at \$140.5K. Most 2023 expenses tend to track that of 2022. The differences are associated with a slight increase for conference committee travel, the elimination of IEEE-USA (PACE) items, the addition of Sections Congress 2023 support, an increase in the student branch training budget for more face-to-face training, and a reduction in SoutheastCon 2023 expenses due to one less day based on the anticipated region committee meeting at Sections Congress. A motion was presented to “recommend Region 3 ExCom approve 2023 budget as proposed and approved by FinCom”. The motion was approved.

6) Discussion Agenda

SoutheastCon 2023 Update

SoutheastCon 2023 Chair Joe Juisai provided an update on SoutheastCon 2023. The conference seed loan funding has been received from both Region 3 and the Orlando Section. The technical paper submission was opened on September 25 (20 papers submitted, 6 accepted, 1 rejected) and an update to the student hardware competition rules was posted on October 11. For the student software competition, the UCF software competition team is working on automated scoring and problem fine tuning. Tutorial, workshop and demonstration proposals are due on October 31, using a 2-hour, 4-hour or full-day format. Room assignment planning will begin soon and a punch list of hotel logistic items will be generated. The conference hotel (Orlando Hilton) informed the SoutheastCon 2023 Committee that a \$50K advance deposit was due on October 15 due to the lack of an IEEE credit approval. The conference planning committee has contacted IEEE Meetings, Conferences and Events (MCE) to determine why the IEEE credit approval was not granted.

MCE is currently working to resolve the issue. Also, for some unknown reason, the SoutheastCon 2023 concentration banking account was opened with a negative \$5K balance. IEEE NextGen Banking was contacted to investigate the matter. A discussion on possibilities for conference sponsors followed.
