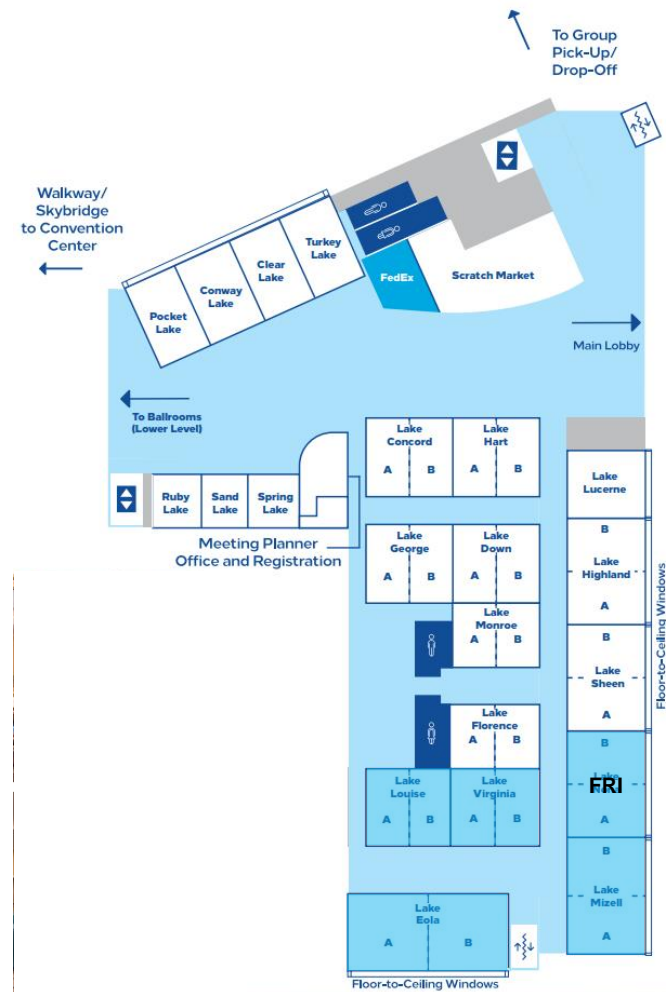

# Technical Program Update



- Papers

- 235 papers submitted
- 168 papers accepted (106 regular in-person, 46 virtual, 16 posters)
- 67 papers rejected
- Comparison to 2022 Mobile conference

Virtual	63 (54 percent)	46 (27 percent)
In-Person	54 (46 percent)	122 (73 percent)

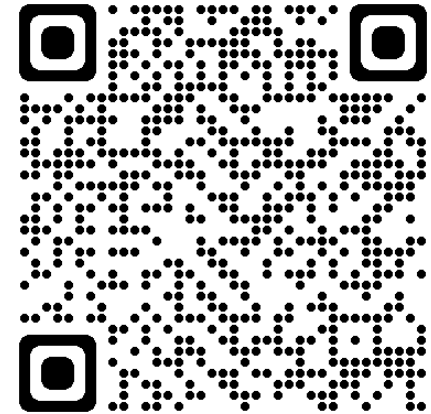
