

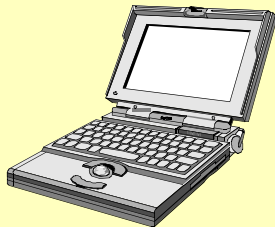
## WE ARE IEEE CANADA

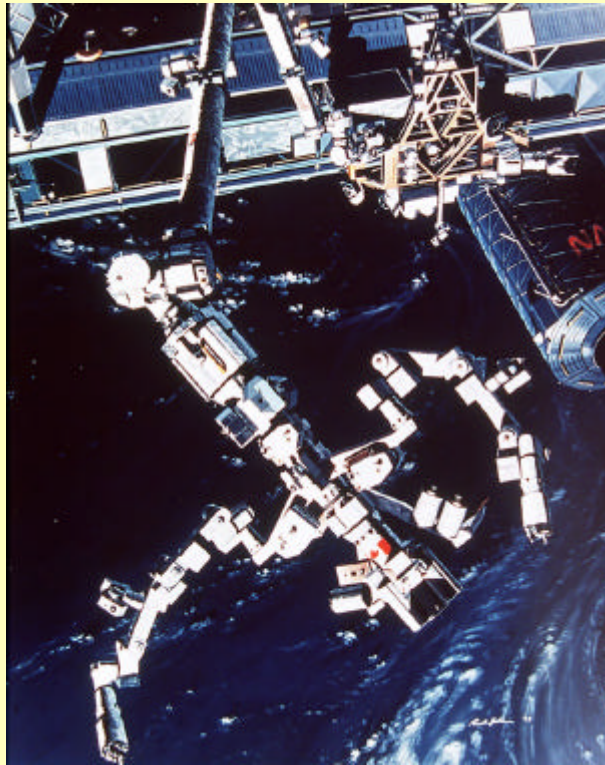

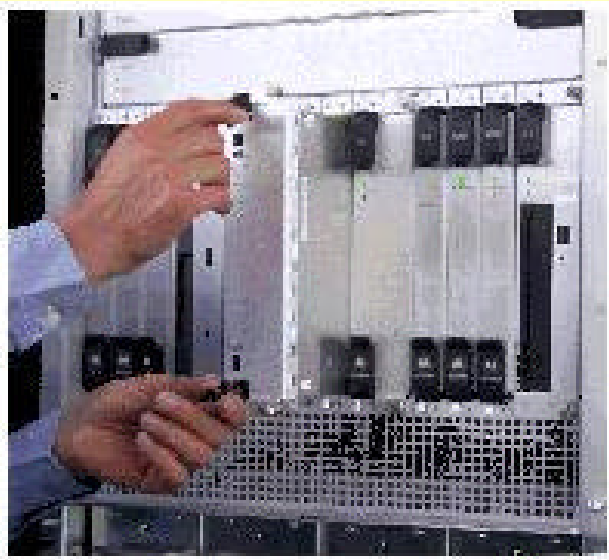
