In case of multiple authors of a paper, at least one author must register and present the paper. All accepted papers will be considered for publication provided at least one author registers and attends the conference. If authors other than presenting authors are willing to attend the contest, separate registration fees should be paid per person.

## Information for the participants of the Circuit Design Contest:

Prospective students are invited to submit electronic version of the Design manuscript not exceeding 2 pages as per IEEE double column format stating the purpose, utility and functionality. Only circuit designs with suitable humanitarian applicability and some extent of novelty will be accepted for evaluation. All the manuscript will be subjected to a review process before final acceptance. All the manuscripts are to be submitted electronically using the email ID [nspcdc2011@gmail.com](mailto:nspcdc2011@gmail.com). The author's has to send an electronic version of a signed statement from their academic advisor stating that the work is principally the effort of the students along with their manuscript. At least one author must register and present their design in form of a poster presentation along with the working design set up. Kindly mention the apparatus and their specifications required for demonstration in the manuscript.
