### Report presented at Adcom October 19<sup>th</sup>, 2009 IEEE EDUCON 2010 on-going report

The development of the EDUCON 2010 conference continues the expected steps.

The one page IEEE double column abstract review process has finished. We have received 374 abstracts, (Full papers 247, Short papers 116, Round table 1, Special session 5 and Panel 5). After the first selection a 80% acceptance has done, with a 298 abstracts accepted (and a 20% rejection, 76 abstracts).

Next peer-review selection will begin on November 15<sup>th</sup>, after the complete paper deadline. We will need around 250 reviewers and we will have a Call for reviewers (as we have around 100 now in the different committees of the conference).

Final signature of MoU and financial MoU are signed by UNEED, UOM and CTI as well as by EdSoc representative, and are in the final stage at the IEEE signature.

All information is loaded in the website, including registration prices, VISA issues and Committees. Honour committee is finally configured with the Presidency of the Royal Highness the Prince of Asturias. The President of Madrid Autonomous Community, 3 Spanish Ministries and the Madrid Mayor are included, as well as the IEEE EdSoc president, the IEEE Region 8 Chair and the Spanish Section Chair.

Keynote Speakers are finally closed. Susan Lord, President of our Society, Patricia Manson, Head of Unit, Cultural Heritage and Technology Enhanced Learning in the Directorate General Information Society and Media of the European Commission and Javier Uceda, Rector of the Polytechnic University of Madrid and IEEE Fellow.

There is on-going the preparation of an Award web page. First Award will be named as "IEEE Education Society Annual Global Engineering Conference (EDUCON) Meritorious Service Award". And Best paper awards, separated in 5 areas, each year will be an award in each category as well as a special nomination. The best of them will be proposed to send articles for the journals and magazines that we have agreed for each conference (IEEE Trans on Education, IEEE-RITA, OnlineJournals.org, etc.).

Hotel prices and booking numbers as well as logistic issues are been closing now, to open the registration web site and hotel booking are in January 2010.

In total there are 411 users of the ConfTool systems registered now. Abstracts received are from:
