Instructions for completing the 2002 IEEE IAS Annual Meeting Registration FORM

1. Please fill out the application completely. In the first section be sure to include your **IEEE/IEEJ/AEI** Member number if you are applying as a member. ***Please circle the appropriate category.*** Failure to include your member number will delay your application. Include your daytime telephone number and e-mail address so you can be contacted in the event of a problem with the application.
2. In the space marked “Badge Name”, please fill in your **First Name** as you would like it to appear on your badge.
3. If a guest is accompanying you, please fill in name as you would like it to appear on their badge.
4. **Authors**, please include your paper number(s) in the space provided. ***List all papers you have authored for this conference in the space provided.*** All authors including students must register and pay the appropriate fees. A minimum of a one-day registration fee must accompany all paper submissions for the paper to be published in the conference proceedings and listed in the program. For every paper presented, there must be an author or coauthor paying the minimum of a one-day registration fee even if the author is a student.
5. Be sure to complete the sections on IEEE affiliation and Attendance at previous meetings. **“GOLD” – Graduates Of the Last Decade** - Please check this box if you received your BS degree within the last ten years.
6. Early registration concludes on **August 30th 2002**. All registrations received after that date will be processed at the on-site rate.
7. **Full registration** levels include all sessions, the proceedings on CD-ROM plus the following:
 - * Member/Non-Member: Reception/Cruise Sunday Evening, Awards Luncheon Tuesday, Banquet Wednesday
 - ** Regular Student: Reception/Cruise, Myron Zucker Lunch, Awards Luncheon Tuesday, Banquet Wednesday
 - *** Economy Student Registration: Myron Zucker Lunch ONLY
 - **** IEEE Life Member Registration: Special Reception Monday
8. **One-Day registration** level includes all sessions for that day and proceedings on CD-ROM. Please indicate the day that you are registering for. If you register for one day, you can only purchase an event for you or your guest that occurs on the day you are registered for.
9. If you are a **non-member registrant**, your registration fee includes a one year membership in IEEE and IAS.
10. **All tutorials** are on Sunday October 13th 2002. Morning tutorials run from 8:00 AM until Noon. Afternoon tutorials run from 1:00 PM to 5:00 PM. The all day tutorial runs from 8:00 AM until Noon, and from 1:00 PM until 5:00 PM. Tutorials do not include lunch. Lunch is the responsibility of the attendee.
