Brief Minutes

Shahriar Mirabbasi was nominated by Wouter Serdijn; the nomination was supported, and Shahriar accepted.

Led by our CAS present Georges Gielen, discussion for miscellaneous needs including nominations CAS Board of Governors, ideas for future workshops. Randy Geiger also suggested expanding out presence/thrust to something including the emerging technology area--for example, Bio technology. Ralph Etienne-Cummings also brought up needs to identify new special sessions for next year's ISCAS (2006).

Tuna Tarim brought up whether to pursue again the ISCAS Special Issue in the Kluwer journal (Analog Integrated Circuits and Signal Processing). Last year's (ISCAS-2004) special issue in print for May-2005 issue. It was agreed to pursue the same for ISCAS-2005, with Tuna and Igor Filanovsky as the guest editors. For future, it was generally agreed that we should pursue getting a general annual ISCAS special issue in the IEEE TCAS-I journal.

Three people [were] volunteered to run for CAS Board of Governors: Ramesh Harjani, Tuna Tarim, Ralph Etienne-Cummings will run for the office, and the ASPTC members endorsed them by signing nomination sheets.
