

Call for IMTC 2007 Student Paper Contest

Undergraduate and graduate students are invited to submit papers to the IMTC 2007 Student Paper Contest sponsored by the IEEE Instrumentation and Measurement Society. Both travel awards and best paper awards will be made.

Travel awards of up to USD 1,000 for reimbursable expenses will be competitively awarded for papers selected for presentation. Best paper awards will consist of up to two Undergraduate Student Outstanding Paper awards of USD 500 and up to two Graduate Student Outstanding Paper awards of USD 500.

Eligibility Criteria:

- The first author of a paper must have been a student at the time when the reported research work was done, and at the time of the Conference must still be a student or have graduated within the last year.
- This paper must be presented at IMTC 2007 by a student.
- This paper must be submitted in accordance with rules of IMTC 2007 paper submissions, and should be specified as a paper to be considered for the IMTC 2007 Student Paper Contest.

Selection Criteria:

- The technical content and writing quality of the eligible papers will be evaluated by the same technical reviewers that review the extended abstracts for IMTC 2007; the final selection will be made by the IMTC 2007 Technical Program Co-Chairs.
- The oral presentation of the eligible papers at the Conference will be also evaluated by the same technical reviewers that review the extended abstracts for IMTC 2007.
- The results of both evaluations will be summed up and used for ranking the eligible papers.

Awards Distribution:

- The recipients of travel awards will be notified in advance of the Conference.
- The best paper awards will be presented at the IMTC 2007 Gala Dinner on May 2, 2007.
