Topic

High electricity and natural gas prices have created severe energy budgeting and planning difficulties for many commercial, government and institutional utility customers in Texas. Uncertainty over energy prices, equipment performance, weather and other factors make energy-related decisions exceedingly complicated.

Objective

This half-day workshop shows attendees how to evaluate financial risk associated with energy efficiency and operating options using a risk management process called Energy Budgets at Risk (EBaR)[™]. EBaR evaluates energy cost saving options providing a strategy that recognizes each organization's budget flexibility and risk tolerance.

Who Should Attend?

Workshops are designed for a nontechnical audience. Building owners, managers and others responsible for electric and natural gas budgets in commercial, industrial, government and institutional buildings will gain sufficient knowledge to immediately begin developing energy risk management strategies. The workshop is also appropriate for executives who want to gain an understanding of energy risk management principles.
