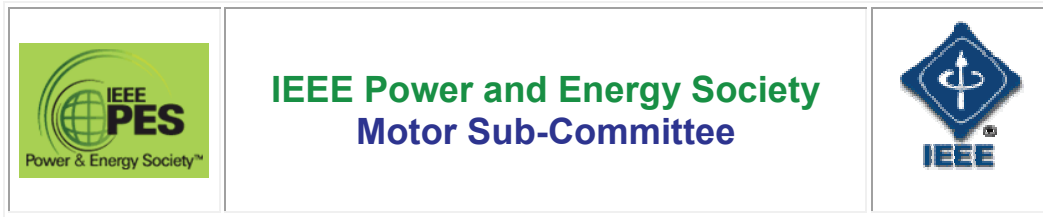

The IEEE PES Motor Sub-Committee (MSC) of the Electric Machinery Committee (EMC) is planning to organize Panel Sessions on the above topics during the 2012 IEEE- PES General Meeting, to be held on July 22-27 at the Manchester Grand Hyatt in San Diego, California, USA. Prospective authors are encouraged to submit a double-spaced single-column 2-page extended abstract in pdf or MS word file format. Please specify the session of your interest and submit the extended abstract to the Chair-Elect of MSC, Professor Akira Chiba from the Tokyo Institute of Technology, at the following e-mail address: chiba@ee.titech.ac.jp. Please cc the appropriate session chair from the list above.

The scheduled deadlines are:

October 7, 2011 – Extended abstract (2-page) deadline

October 30, 2011 – Panel session paper proposal acceptance notification

November 30, 2011 – **Firm deadline** for uploading panel papers on the 2012 PES General Meeting website.

February, 2012 – Notification will be provided only if the paper needs revisions or if it is rejected.

Note that panel sessions participants must submit a two to six page written summary of the presentation material so that it can be published in the conference proceedings. If you are planning a future submission of the material as an IEEE Transactions paper, please review the IEEE Policy Regarding Plagiarism in section 6.4.1h) located here: <http://www.ieee-pes.org/part-2-preparation-and-submission-of-transactions-papers>. Authors should note that in order to subsequently submit a panel session summary as a transaction paper, authors are required to indicate how the new submission offers substantively novel contributions beyond those of the panel session summary. Plan your submission accordingly. It will generally be easier to accomplish this by submitting only a brief 2 page summary for the purposes of the panel session and an extended version with full details of the work for a transaction submission.

All accepted panel session papers will be included in the IEEEExplore archival database provided that they are presented at the 2012 IEEE- PES General Meeting.
