## INTRODUCTION

Sustainability, by one definition, means development that meets the needs of the present without compromising the needs of future generations.

Carbon and other emissions such as methane result, and these in turn dramatically unbalance the planet's delicate temperature and chemical makeup.

The ensuing environmental shift has increasingly devastating effects on the world and its inhabitants: Hurricane Katrina, the Asian Tsunami, droughts, heat waves, and floods. We need to find all possible solutions and encourage everyone on whatever level, and wherever they may be to play their part.

The International Conference on Energy and Environment 2009 (ICEE2009), with the theme - *“Advancement Towards Global Sustainability”* aims to bring together researchers, scientists, engineers, and university students to exchange and share their experiences, new ideas, and research results about all aspects of Energy, Environment, Sustainable Development, as well as discuss the practical challenges encountered and the solutions adopted.

## ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

Papers on any of the conference scope are invited. One copy of an extended abstract should be submitted before 1<sup>st</sup> May 2009. The extended abstract should include the author's name(s) and affiliation(s), title of the paper, objective of the research, main results, and conclusion followed by five key words. Abstracts could be submitted, preferably, online or via email to ICEE2009@uniten.edu.my.

If the abstract is accepted, the author(s) submits a full paper suitable for publication in the conference proceedings. A full review of the papers with the referees' comments will be sent to the author(s). The finalized versions of the papers are required by an absolute deadline of 1st July 2009.

Selected papers will be considered for publication in the Journal of Energy and Environment. The official language of the conference is English.
