Basic Terms and Conditions

1. Contract

This application, properly executed by Applicant (Consultant) shall, upon written acceptance and notification of booths assigned by PSE 2008 management, constitute a valid and binding contract.

2. Assignment of Space

Assignment of space to Consultants is **based upon the IEEE/PSE Consultant's Corner allocation point system**. PSE 2008 will continue to receive applications and assign Exhibit space, as it remains available, until shortly before the show opening date. In all cases, total Consultant's Corner payments must be received prior to show opening. **PSE 2008's** assignment of booths is final and shall constitute an acceptance of the Consultant's offer to occupy space. After assignment, space location may not be changed, transferred or cancelled by the Consultant **except** upon written request and with the subsequent written approval of PSE 2008 management. **PSE 2008 management reserves the right to reassign Consultant space or to modify floor plan for overall benefit of the show.**

3. Subletting Space

No Consultant will assign, sublet, or apportion the whole or any part of the space allotted to him, nor exhibit therein, nor permit any other person or party to exhibit therein, any other goods, apparatus, etc. not manufactured or distributed by the Consultant in the regular course of his business except upon prior written consent of PSE Management.

4. Consultant's Corner Space Rental Rates

Consultant's Corner Space rental includes materials and services described herein.

Standard Show Price Per Consultant's Corner space: Full Consultant's Corner price \$200.00, if payment received with deposit on or before 04-August-2008.

Consultant's Corner include: Table, chair and space.

Consultants are subject to hotel storage charges.

Consultants are subject to shipping charges.

5. Payment Requirements and Cancellation Charges

Applications require a 100% deposit before final Consultant's Corner assignment is confirmed in writing. All applicants must be paid in full by 03-September-2008.

All cancellations must be made in writing and will be based on the following schedule of refunds: On or before **15-August-2008**...50% of total Consultant's Corner cost will be refunded. After **29-August-2008**...No Refund will be permitted. "No-show" Consultants will receive no refund. **Space reductions are considered cancellations and are subject to cancellation fees.**

It is understood that PSE 2008 reserves the right, at its option, to reassign a cancelled Consultant's Corner regardless of the cancellation rate assessed.

In the event that the premise in which the PSE 2008 Show is conducted shall become, in the sole discretion of PSE 2008, unfit for occupancy, or substantially interfered with by reason of any cause or causes not reasonably within the control of PSE 2008, this agreement may be terminated by PSE 2008. For this purpose, the term "cause or causes" shall include, but not by way of limitation, fire, flood, epidemic, earthquake, explosion or accident, blockage, embargo, inclement weather, governmental restraints, restraints or orders of civil defense, or military authorities, act of public enemy, riot or civil disturbance, strike, lockout, boycott or other labor disturbance, inability to secure sufficient labor, technical or other personnel, failure, impairment or lack of adequate transportation facilities, inability to obtain, or condemnation,

requisition or commandeering of necessary supplies or equipment, local, state or federal law, ordinance, rule, order, decree or regulation, whether legislative, executive, or judicial, and whether constitutional, or act of God. Should PSE 2008 terminate this agreement pursuant to the provision of this paragraph the Consultant waives any and all claims for damages and agrees that PSE 2008 may, after computing the total amount of PSE 2008 cost and expenses in connection with its preparation for and conducting of the PSE 2008 Show, (including a reasonable reserve for claims and other contingencies), refund to the Consultant, as and for complete settlement and discharge of all said Consultant's claims and demands, an amount which bears the same relationship to the fee paid by said Consultant as the total refundable amount as computed above bears to the total amount of fees paid by all Consultants.

6. Consultant's Corner Manning and Dismantling Schedule

A representative may man Consultant's Corner Space during all times when Exhibition is officially open. Consultant's Corner Space must be maintained in a neat and orderly manner throughout the Exhibition. Consultants may begin dismantling **only** after **3:00pm Tuesday, 21-October-2008**. Move out **must** be completed by **11:59 p.m., Tuesday, 21-October-2008**. Consultants are responsible for removal of all materials used in their display. Any Consultant leaving materials **after 11:59 p.m., Tuesday, 21-October-2008** will be charged for the materials' removal. **Failure to observe this rule, including early dismantling, will result in a \$1,000 (U.S. Currency) fine and may jeopardize the Consultant's space assignments or right to exhibit at future conferences sponsored by IEEE/PSE.**

7. Loss or Damage

Consultant agrees with PSE 2008 that PSE 2008 shall not be liable for any damage or liability of any kind or for any loss, damage or injury to persons or property during the term of this agreement, from any cause whatsoever by reason of use, occupation and enjoyment of Consultant's Corner Space by Consultant or any person thereof with the consent of Consultant, and that Consultant will defend, indemnify and save harmless, PSE 2008 from all liability whatsoever, on account of any such damage, or injury, whether or not caused by negligence or breach of an obligation by Consultant or its employees or representatives. Consultant will be liable for all damages or liability of any kind or for any loss, damage or injury to persons or any property during the show from any cause whatsoever by reason of use, occupation and enjoyment of exhibit space.

8. Demonstrations

No demonstrations or solicitations shall be permitted outside of the Consultant's assigned space, and no signs or placards may be displayed on persons or otherwise outside exhibit spaces.

9. Compliance

The Consultant assumes all responsibility for compliance with all pertinent ordinances, regulations and codes of duly authorized local, State and federal governing bodies concerning fire, safety and health, together with the rules and regulations of the operators and/or owners of the property wherein the Show is held.

10. Unions

It is further agreed that the Consultant will abide by and comply with rules and regulations concerning local unions having agreements with the PSE 2008 Show Facility or with authorized contractors employed by PSE 2008.

11. Management

The Consultant further agrees that the conditions, rules and regulations of the PSE 2008 management are made a part of this contract and that said Consultant agrees to be bound by each and all of these rules and regulations, and that the management shall have the full power to interpret, amend and enforce all rules and regulations in the best interest of the Show.
