



Trinity Railway Express

TRE offers commuter rail service between Fort Worth and Dallas. View schedule here at www.trinityrailwayexpress.org. TRE also serves DFW airport through the CentrePort station (no service on Sundays). Free transport is available to and from DFW Airport to CentrePort station for access to TRE trains. Train fare from CenterPort to Ft. Worth is \$2.50 USD one way per person. Departing Passengers, follow signs to the designated Remote South Parking bus pick-up zones on the lower level of all Terminals. At the Remote South Parking lot, connect to buses serving the TRE CentrePort station. Buses depart every 15 minutes.
