



## CITY TOUR MAISONNEUVE... CITY OF DUFRESNE AND NINCHERI ARTIST

Discover the history of a very special district meaningful for the Montrealers

This tour will help you understand Maisonneuve an industrial city at the end of the 19th Century and also understand the dream of the Dufresne brothers who wanted their city to become the small Pittsburgh of Canada.

It is also the district of the **Olympic Park**... On our way we will show the Olympic Village, also known as the Olympic Pyramids. All the athletes were lodging in those two buildings, a few steps away from the stadium.

And now, the masterpiece... The famous **Olympic Stadium** designed by French architect Roger Taillibert. Your guide will talk about the construction of this impressive building, as well as all the Olympic adventures.

You will have the privilege of visiting [Château Dufresne](#) built in 1906. This beaux-art-style private mansion presents an interior décor painted by the artist Guido Nincheri ([stained-glass and frescoes](#)). And for the [first time](#) in 2010 a [visit Guido Nincheri's workshop](#) is also included.
