Final versions of all papers, following all requirements below, must be submitted by no later than March 16, 2018 in order to be included in the conference proceedings and IEEE Xplore.

Before Creating your Final PDF:

- Ensure that you have addressed reviewers' comments as specified in your acceptance email.
- Add the appropriate copyright notice to your source document:
 - For papers in which all authors are employed by the US government, the copyright notice is: **U.S. Government work not protected by U.S. copyright**
 - For papers in which all authors are employed by a Crown government (UK, Canada, and Australia), the copyright notice is: 978-1-5386-1399-3/18/\$31.00 ©2018 Crown
 - For papers in which all authors are employed by the European Union, the copyright notice is: 978-1-5386-1399-3/18/\$31.00 ©2018 European Union
 - For all other papers the copyright notice is: 978-1-5386-1399-3/18/\$31.00 ©2018 IEEE

Ensuring IEEE Xplore Compliance:

All accepted papers must be IEEE Xplore compliant. To ensure that your file is fully compliant with IEEE Xplore, you must validate your paper with IEEE PDF eXpress using conference ID 42817X.

All errors identified by PDF eXpress must be corrected prior to final submission to the conference. Once your paper is free of errors, you will receive a pdf file from PDF eXpress with a name in the following format: PIDxxxxxxxx.pdf. This is the file that must be uploaded for your final submission.
