Guidelines for Best Interactive (Poster) Paper Award Finalists

For Best Interactive (Poster) Paper Award Finalists, in addition to prepare a poster, you are also required to make a 5-mins virtual presentation video to introduce your work. You should record your PPT presentation video and upload the video file via the EDAS paper submission portal, following the steps below. This applies to all poster Finalists (even if you will present your poster paper in-person since some judges may only be available virtually).

NOTE: All the videos of Best Interactive Paper Award Finalists will be posted online. The Finalist video presentations will be watched and evaluated by the Award Selection Committee, and the Best Interactive Paper Awards will be selected based upon both the technical merits of the poster papers and the video presentations.



Instructions for Recording PPT Presentation as a Video

Example with Microsoft Office 2019

Step 1: select Slide Show > Record Slide Show

Step 2: choose from two options:

- Record from Current Slide
- Record from Beginning

Step 3: when ready, select **Record** and start presentation/speaking

Step 4: manage your recording:

Pause: to pause a recording

Stop: to end a recording

Replay: to replay a recording

 Pen, Highlighter, Eraser: use the pen, highlighter or eraser tools to mark up your presentation/recording

Step 5: Remove your recording: select **Clear** and choose from options

Step 6: save a recording as a video: select File > Export
