

## Guidelines for Uploading Your EDTM2021 Virtual Poster File (PPT Format) via EDAS Paper Submission Portal

For Virtual poster presentations, you should prepare your poster using the provided PPT template (**do not convert to PDF**) and then upload the file (PPT format) via the EDAS paper submission portal, following the steps below:

Step 1: Logon to your account on EDAS: <https://edas.info/N27705>, go to My...→My profile (Note: if your dropdown menu does not work, please directly copy & paste this link to your web browser: <https://edas.info/showSelf.php?c=27705>):
