Call for Abstracts for Presentations and Training Workshops is Now Open for 3rd Annual INCOSE New England Fall Workshop

The INCOSE New England chapter will be hosting its third annual fall workshop on October 22nd and 23rd, 2021. The workshop will be conducted as a two-day virtual event. The workshop is aimed at creating a forum for the systems engineering community to network, share ideas, knowledge, and practices, and learn more about the most recent innovations, trends, experiences, and issues in all aspects of systems engineering from world-class thought leaders in the field.

This year's workshop will be themed around two tracks - Systems Thinking and Integration, Verification & Validation (IV&V). Submission Instructions:

- 1. Authors will need to submit an abstract only for review and acceptance.
- 2. Authors will first need to establish a free Easy Chair account for presentation or tutorial abstract submissions. Follow the link above and either (a) select the Create an Account link if you do not currently have an Easy Chair Account or (b) login with your existing Easy Chair account. - 3. You will be directed to the submission page in Easy Chair to submit your abstract.
- 4. Then select Make a New Submission in Easy Chair.
- 5. For submission review, authors must submit author information, title, abstract, keywords, type of submission (abstract or tutorial), and preferred track in Easy Chair.
