IEEE Region 8 and Tech4Good are partnering to conduct a collaborative **call for proposals to support SIGHT Groups (and prospective SIGHT Groups) in Region 8** who would like to address local community challenges. The core aim of this call for proposals is to support SIGHT Groups with great initiatives and creative technological solutions for local communities. Proposed solutions must have a sustainability plan in line with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals and take into account cost-effectiveness, environmental sustainability, trust-enhancement, relevance to users and community, community buy-in, and accessibility. Applicants must submit their letter of intent by 06 September.

Call for Project Proposals Now Open: IEEE AP-S, MTT-S, and Tech4Good



The IEEE Tech4Good (T4G) program offers funding opportunities to support grassroots technological projects, led by IEEE members, that address local challenges related to sustainable development. The IEEE Microwave Theory & Technology Society (MTT-S) and the IEEE Antennas and Propagation Society (AP-S) are partnering with T4G to conduct a call for proposals to support humanitarian technology projects for MTT-S and AP-S members that utilize technologies in their fields of interest to address local community challenges.

Applicants must be active IEEE members and either AP-S or MTT-S members and teams should include other members from the local chapter. Grants of US\$3,000 to US\$6,000 will be made to selected proposals that present a six-month plan to deploy a technical solution in the AP-S & MTT-S fields of expertise that meets a current need of a local community.

Empower a Billion Lives Team Registration is now Open



The IEEE Power Electronics Society is thrilled to announce the launch of **Empower a Billion Lives (EBL) 2025**, a global competition aimed at crowdsourcing scalable solutions for energy access. This initiative invites student teams, small and medium-sized companies, research labs, international corporations, and non-profit organizations to participate in a mission that can transform lives worldwide. **Concept papers** are due by 01 November.

SIGHT Group Activity Initiative



The IEEE SIGHT Committee is excited to share that it is providing funding to established and active Groups to support their humanitarian technology activities in 2024. Eligible SIGHT Groups may submit applications to receive up to US\$200. Only one activity will be approved per Group. Possible uses for the funds include events, training and professional development, communications and marketing materials, prototype development or project preparation, and operational needs.
