U.S. Army Corps of Engineers – Providing Engineering and Construction Services to the Nation and the World

Brig. Gen. Thomas J. Tickner is the commanding general and division engineer for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) North Atlantic Division. He oversees an annual program of more than \$5 billion to plan, design and construct projects to support the military and various engineering related projects.

Brig. Gen. Tickner will discuss how the North Atlantic Division - one of nine USACE regional commands - provides engineering and construction services to the nation. Challenges can include humanitarian assistance, deepening federal channels and harbors. Brig. Gen. Tickner's talk will feature USACE support to emergency and contingency operations – like USACE support to FEMA for the COVID response.
