The summary should be documented in MS word or PDF. Prospective authors are requested to intimate by e-mail, their readiness to present a paper, with full postal address etc in advance to enable us to keep in touch and update with info brochures etc.

#### Instructions for Full Paper Submission

Proceedings containing Full papers presented at IMEC-2004 will be published in a book—form. The following are guidelines to ensure uniformity

- 1 Title of the Paper should appear at the top entered in Arial font, size 15, all upper case, bold and centrealigned.
- 2 Name(s) of Author(s), should be entered in Arial Font size 12, Title Case, bold and centre aligned. One line spacing to be left between title of the paper and author name.
- 3 Leaving one line space below author(s) name(s) one address for correspondence with phone No., fax No. etc. to be entered in Arial Font, size 10, title case and NOT bold. The last line of the address field should be e-mail ID in bold.
- $4\,Leaving\,one\,line\,space below the\,address field\,the\,heading\,ABSTRACT in upper case, a rial font and size 10, centre\,aligned\,and\,bold\,should\,appear.\,From this point on wards in the complete paper use Arial Font, size 10$
- 5 The abstract matter starts as a paragraph below the heading ABSTRACT. NOT bold but in Italics. The Abstract should be approximately 200 words ( $\pm 10$ ). The abstract may be followed by key words for indexing etc.
- 6 Nowthe paper starts leaving one line spacing below the abstract with a heading of INTRODUCTION, left aligned, bold and upper case. All sub headings should be in title case, left aligned and bold.

7 Authors Bio-data Format - Adjust photosize and text to limit all authors bio-data to one page.

Authors are requested to send their Full papers as an e-mail attachment by 31 July 2004.
