

# CS IDEATE HAKEETHON

## REPORT

**CS IDEATE Hakeethon** was an excellent initiative taken by IEEE CS Chapter of Hyderabad Section in association with Vardhaman College of Engineering and Sri Venkateswara College of Engineering. It was a 24-hour Hakeethon which commenced on 28th of March, 2020 at 12 a.m. and ended at 23:59 p.m. Volunteers are the backbone of every event conducted under the hood of IEEE and the volunteers of **CS IDEATE Hakeethon** did not fail to prove it again. The relentless support from Mr. Vidya Sagar, the Chairperson of the IEEE CS Chapter Hyderabad Section proved to be one of the prominent motives behind the success of this Hakeethon. Alongside Dr. M.A. Jabbar, Executive Committee member of IEEE CS Hyderabad Section; Dr. Krishna Prasad, HoD, CSE Dept. of Sri Venkateswara College of Engineering; Mr. Moola Ramu, IEEE Chapter Advisor, Vaagdevi Engineering College; Dr. Harinath, Branch Counsellor, IEEE GPREC SB and Dr. Rajanikanth, Treasurer, IEEE CS Chapter Hyderabad Section provided major support as well.

The Hakeethon was operated on HackerRank platform where more than 50 problem statements comprising various levels of difficulties were given as a challenge. The registrations started a week prior to the date of the competition i.e., March 21, 2020, and ended on March 27, 2020, at 8:00 p.m. to give the students ample time for preparation.

The most awaited competition began at 12:00 a.m. on March 28, 2020, with more than 100 participants logging into the HackerRank link provided by organizers and actively solving problems at breakneck speed. The response of the participants was unmatched as they did not stop throughout the night. The organizers made a WhatsApp group where all the participants were added and constantly pushed to accomplish more by announcing the top-performing contestants every hour.

The organisers and volunteers were active throughout the night to make sure there were no glitches faced by the participants and solved each and every query with a lot of patience. They made sure that the competition was a fair one by steering clear of available codes online from various coding platforms. They achieved this by performing a plagiarism check every once in a while. The volunteers also kept the participants entertained by asking them to click their pictures while coding. The best pictures were posted on the social media handles of the Student Branch.
