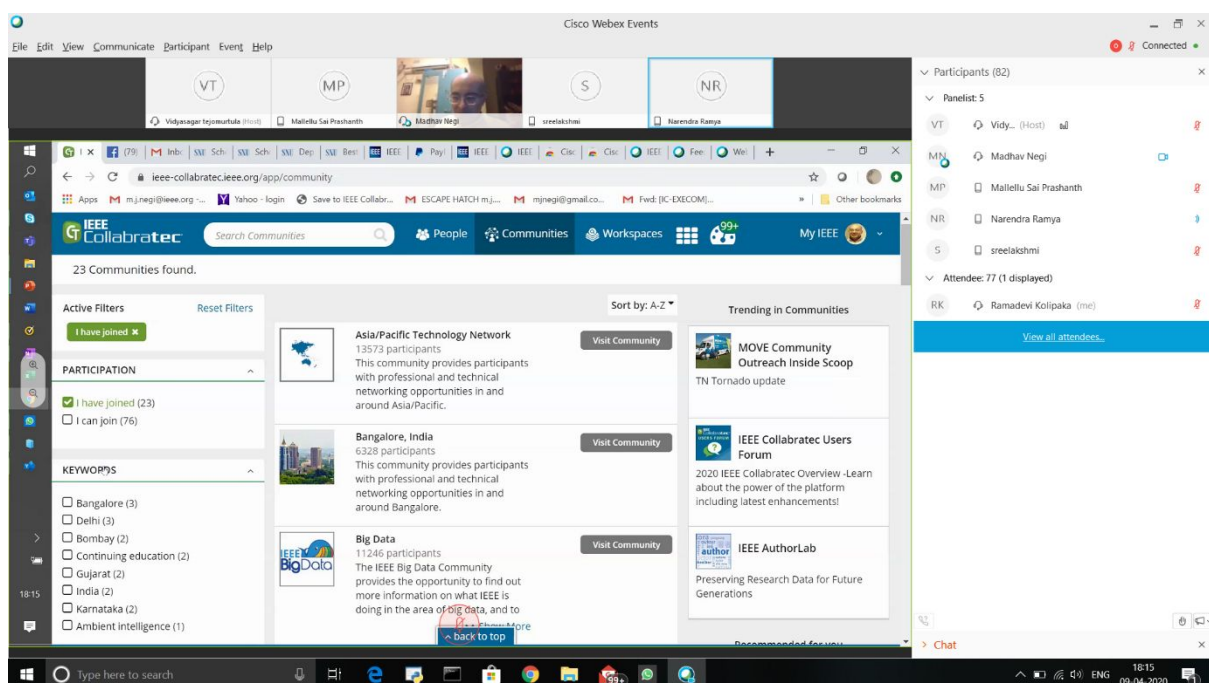
IEEE CS HYDERABAD SECTION **IEEECSHYDERABAD**

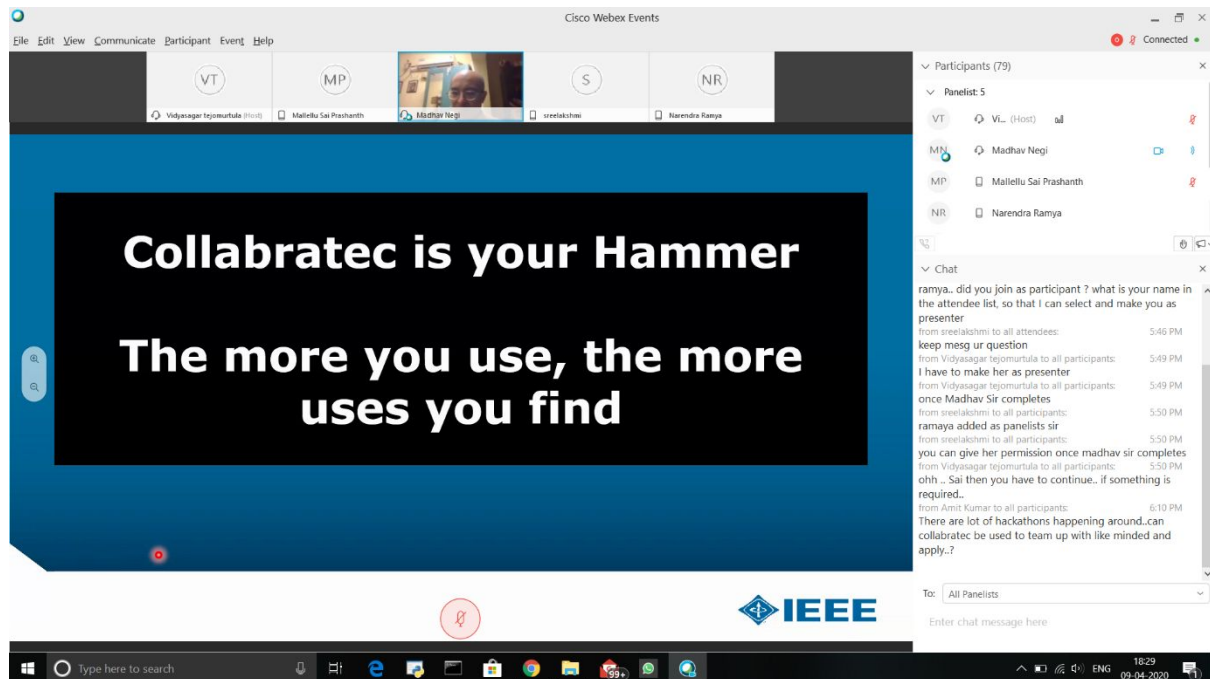
