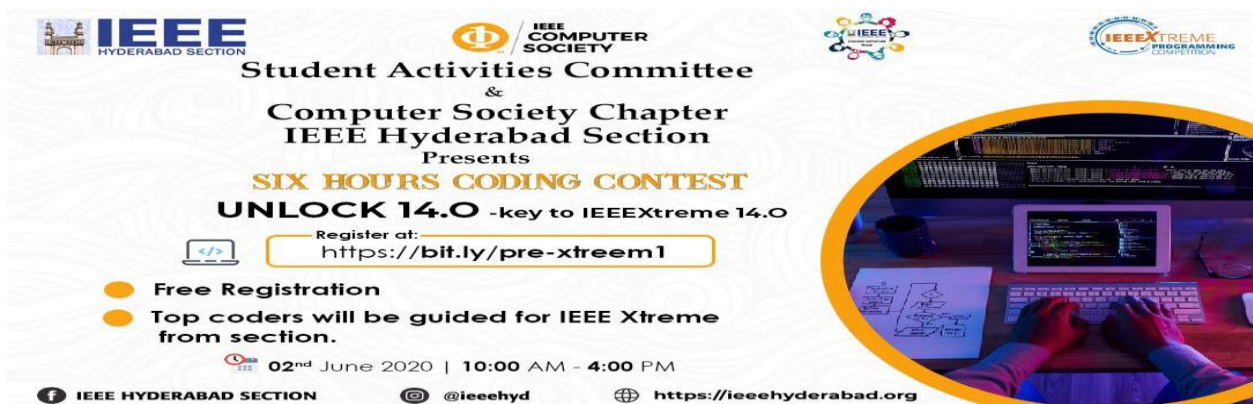


SIX HOURS CODING CONTEST

UNLOCK 14.0-key to IEEE Xtreme 14.0

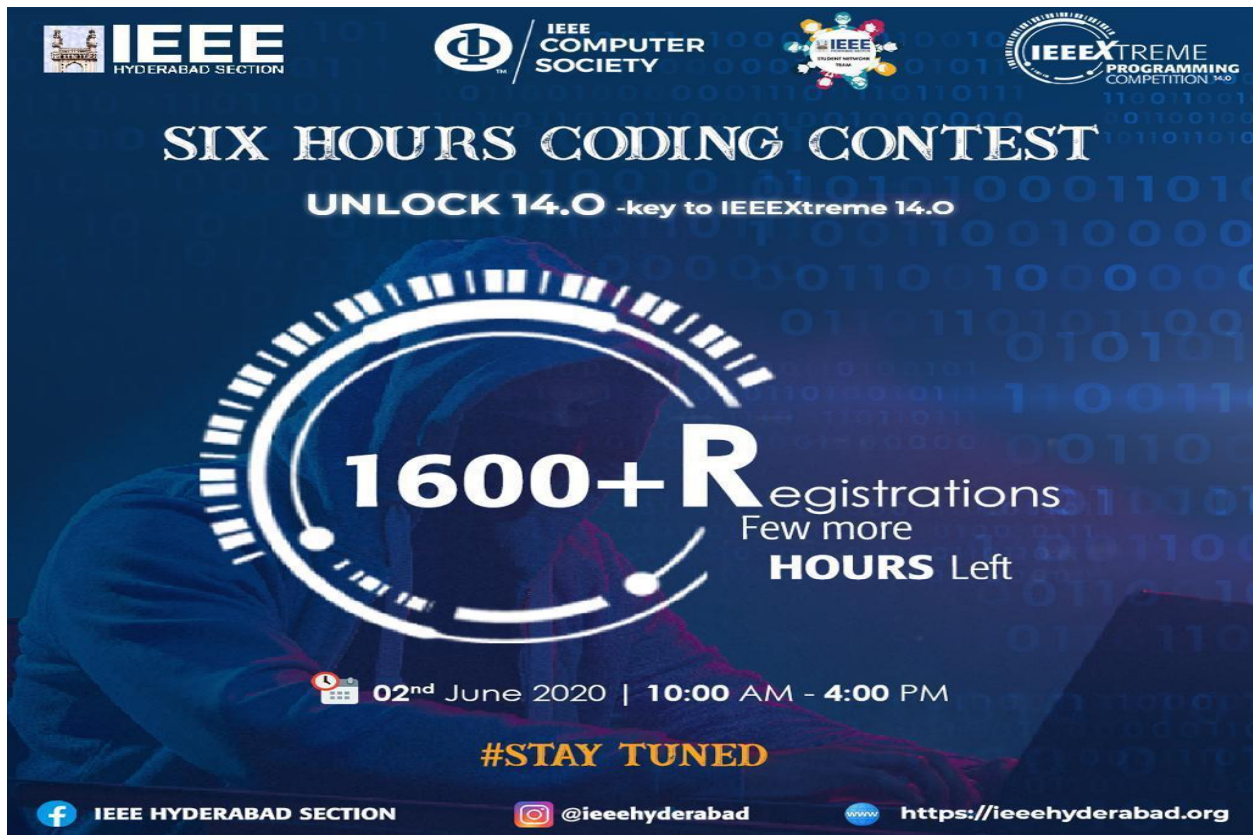
REPORT

UNLOCK 14.0 was an excellent initiative taken by IEEE Hyderabad Section in association with the Student Activities Committee & Computer Society Chapter and IEEE XTREME PROGRAMMING COMPETITION. It was a 6 hours coding contest that commenced on the 2nd of June, 2020 at 10 a.m. and ended at 4 p.m. Volunteers are the backbone of every event conducted under the hood of IEEE and the volunteers of IEEE Hyderabad Section did not fail to prove it again. The restless support from Mr. N. Venkatesh, the Chairperson of the IEEE Hyderabad Section proved to be one of the prominent motives behind the success of this UNLOCK 14.0 the six hours coding contest. Along with Dr. G. Sree Lakshmi, the Chairperson of Student Activities Committee; Mr. Vidya Sagar, the Chairperson of the IEEE CS Chapter Hyderabad Section provided major support as well.

The UNLOCK 14.0 was operated on the HackerRank platform where more than 50 problem statements comprising various levels of difficulties were given as a challenge. The registrations started 10 days prior to the date of the competition i.e. May 23, 2020, and ended on June 2, 2020, at 10:00 a.m. to give the students ample time for preparation. The total number of registrations is 2198.



The most awaited competition began at 10:00 a.m. on June 2nd, 2020, with 1608 participants logging into the HackerRank link provided by organizers and actively solving problems at breakneck speed. The response of the participants was unmatched as they did not stop till 4:00 p.m.










The organizers and volunteers were active for six hours to make sure there were no glitches faced by the participants and solved each and every query with a lot of patience. They made sure that the competition was a fair one by steering clear of available codes online from various coding platforms. They achieved this by performing a plagiarism check every once in a while. The volunteers also kept the participants entertained by asking them to click their pictures while coding. The best pictures were posted on the social media handles of the Student Branch.
