


The UNLOCK 14.0 Code Contest-3 was operated on the CODECHEF platform where more than 50 problem statements comprising various levels of difficulties were given as a challenge. The registrations started 10 days prior to the date of the competition i.e. June 12, 2020, and ended on June 21, 2020, at 09:00 a.m. to give the students ample time for preparation. The total number of registrations is 929.



The most awaited competition began at 09:00 a.m. on June 21st , 2020, with 684 participants logging into the CODECHEF platform to the link provided by organizers and actively solving problems at breakneck speed. The response of the participants was unmatched as they did not stop till 9:00 p.m.

The organizers and volunteers were active for 12 hours to make sure there were no glitches faced by the participants and solved each and every query with a lot of patience. They made sure that the competition was a fair one by steering clear of available codes online from various coding platforms. They achieved this by performing a plagiarism check every once in a while. The volunteers also kept the participants entertained by asking them to click their pictures while coding. The best pictures were posted on the social media handles of the Student Branch.
