Yianni Attikiouzel

It is with sadness that the Western Australia Section acknowledges the passing of Professor Yianni Attikiouzel. Distinguished IEEE member and leader.

Yianni held a BSc (Hons) in Electrical Engineering and PhD in Electrical Engineering from Newcastle University.

He work as an academic and researcher in Western Australia. He was Professor at the University of Western Australia from 1976 to 2002, where he was Director of the Centre for Intelligent Information Processing Systems. Then he worked for Murdoch University where he was Executive Dean and Emeritus Professor from 2002 until his passing. During his academic career he wrote over 250 technical publications and 2 books.

Yianni was Chair of the IEEE WA Section from 1988 to 1990, and from 1992 to 1994. He was member of the Industry Research and Development Board of the Commonwealth Department of Science and Technology, where he was a member of the Services and Consumer Products Committee.

He was presented with the 2002 MA Sargent Medal. The Electrical College of Engineers Australia awards this medal annually to an electrical engineer who has made a significant contribution to the practice and/or science of electrical engineering.
