October Executive Committee Meeting Report
October 19, 2008



This report summarizes the meeting of the IEEE Baltimore Section Executive Committee (ExCom) held on October 6, 2008. Appendix 1 is the October 2008 ExCom Meeting Agenda.

1 Introductions

Bill Semancik called the meeting to order. A general introduction of attendees followed. There were 10 IEEE members in attendance. Appendix 2 is a listing of all attendees.

2 Executive Reports

2.1 Chair Report (Bill Semancik)

- Bill discussed Helen Garrison's resignation as Treasurer (to accept new position in Alaska).
- Walt Willing is to assume Treasurer for remainder of Helen's term as soon as his Concentration Banking signature card is accepted by IEEE. Officer voting was suspended to update candidates list, removing Helen and adding Walt.
- Bill has assumed position of Treasurer until Walt receives authorization. Bill is reconstructing Treasurer records; nine items comprising missing receipts and invoices are outstanding.

2.2 Vice Chair Report (David Kisak)

- Sr. Member Grade Event briefly discussed. Dave to send email to Members that meet eligibility requirement of at least 10 years since earliest engineering degree.
- Dave to contact Ann Mack, HEM, to coordinate schedule for 2009 ExComm Meetings and reservation of conference room.

4 Discussion Topics

4.1 Professional Development Seminar (PDS)

- Woman-In-Engineering Conference held in Atlantic City, NJ. Title: "Engineering Your Future". Held October 3 5, 2008. This was 2nd Annual Event.
- John Dentler attended and reported 90 registered to attend. Next year's conference to be held in Northern New Jersey; will be a coordinated R1 and R2 conference.

4.2 Projector

- Projector previously donated to Historic Electronics Museum has failed. A replacement is needed because it is extensively used by Baltimore Section Chapters.
- Research has identified a Viewsonic 1280 x 768 projector for about \$480 at Cosco; with zoom capability cost is about \$1000. By donating to HEM then Baltimore Section will not have to track it in inventory.
- Motion presented and passed to purchase the Viewsonic projector without zoom and a spare bulb. Jeff Friedhoffer to acquire the projector.

4.3 VEX Robot Challenge

- Alan Pressman, PES Chair, seeking sponsorship from Baltimore Section for Baltimore School System's VEX Robot Challenge. Alan is seeking three sponsors to fund a Trophy, Tee Shirts, and Give-aways.
- Discussion on what is really needed was held to address amount of funding to provide. Motion was presented to approve sponsorship conditioned on subsequent e-mail vote to set funding based on clarification of need; motion passed unanimously.

4.4 School-to-Career Advisory Council

- Alan Pressman presented request from Anita Huchins requesting IEEE support on school initiative and curriculum assessment.

- Motion was made and unanimously approved for a \$200 donation.
