- 1. The Sun Trust account was closed on 8/29/00. (Earlier, \$ 2K had been transferred from it to Mellon Bank.) SunTrust issued a check for the balance, which was deposited in Mellon Bank. Also, \$ 2K was transferred from First Regional Bank to Mellon Bank. We now have \$ 41.40 in First Regional and the rest of the ending balance is in Mellon Bank, A/c #0029591 BR4915.
- 2. Credit cards amounts of \$ 2,122.50 (Banquet, Continuing Education and some Ads) were collected by ECHO and deposited in our account with First Regional Bank in California. ECHO deducted a total of \$ 81.10 (Discount \$62.60 @ ~2.95%, Fee \$ 8.50 @ \$ 0.50 per transaction & Service charge \$ 10.00 to maintain the account).
- 3.Mellon Bank pays the interest for a given month on the first of the following month, and we get the report in the middle of the next month after that. Thus, interest for July was credited on Aug. 1, and the report for August will be received in mid September.
