- Membership grew 40 times in the past 25 years
- Given to large technical professional base in China, there is still large room to increase membership in China
- The membership surge momentum caused by formation 7 sections and the China Office
- Student members would like to engage in more activities
- Some student members have no credit cards and find difficult to pay dues
- IEEE visibility is low in industry

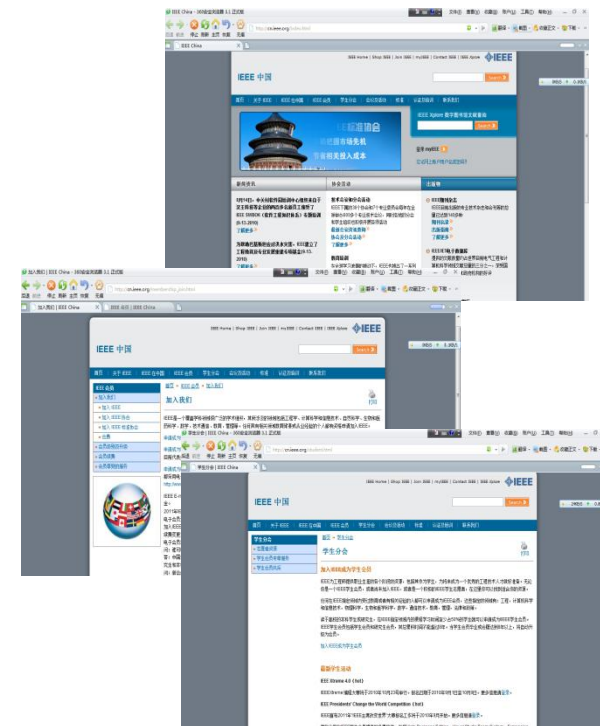
- China Total Membership in Sep 2010 =7,295

IEEE 要点新闻

8月1日, 截止到2010年7月, IEEE 中国已经成立了7个分会 (北京、成都、哈尔滨、上海、西安、南京、武汉), 11个次分会 (合肥、浙江、山东、沈阳、重庆、河北、长沙、广西、广州、太原、昆明), 96个专业技术协会和20个学生分会。
8月14日, 中关村软件园培训中心组织来自于IT业科技等企业的两百多名新员工接受了 IEEE SWOok (软件工程知识库) 和软件工程知识体系与规范的主题培训, 中关村软件园、IEEE CS 首次认证的 CSDA/CSDP 认证培训合作伙伴。
8月17日, 随着来自各个国家开始认识到最近巴基斯坦发生了大规模的水灾, 为响应国际社会的援助, IEEE 建立了工程教育及专业发展基金会, IEEE 的志愿者、会员和工作人员正在为该基金会积极筹款, 第一批捐款达到了 50,000 美元。
8月23日, IEEE 已经批准对于 IEEE P2451-7 “标准”修订工作, 该标准规定了无线传感器和 RFID 标签的方法, 包含内的 RFID 基础设施传感器的数据, 此次修订项目将提供传感器网络制造和部署方面进一步的指导, 并促进传感器和 RFID 系统的互操作性, 该项目还将提供更多的设备和设备互操作性的机会。

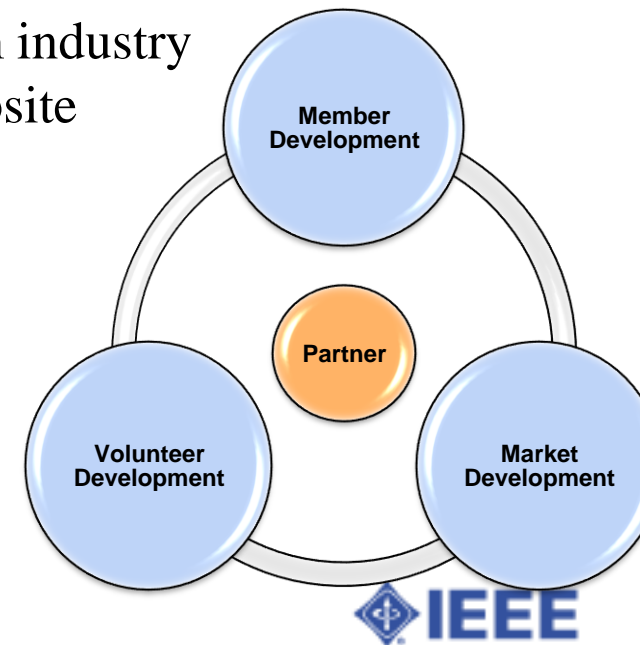

MGM Program Overview

- Member-Get-a-Member rewards current IEEE members for referring new members to join.
- Members receive \$15 per higher grade member recruited.
 - \$2 per student member recruited
 - HG members cannot earn awards on students recruited.
 - Annual max award of \$90 per member.



MGM Program Overview

- Awards are assessed at the end of the membership year in September, and are sent to eligible recruiters in the form of a promotion code that can be used toward:
 - membership renewal,
 - IEEE products and services,
 - a donation to the IEEE Foundation,
 - IEEE merchandise site eCertificates.



MGM Program Overview



- Pre-printed MGM Referral Cards in every member's renewal or new member acknowledgement pack
 - Potential for every member to hand out 4 cards to prospective members
 - Downloadable, editable PDF online for members who need more
- Section awards
 - Top 5 recruiters in each region receive an additional award for their section
 - Top overall recruiter receives an additional section award

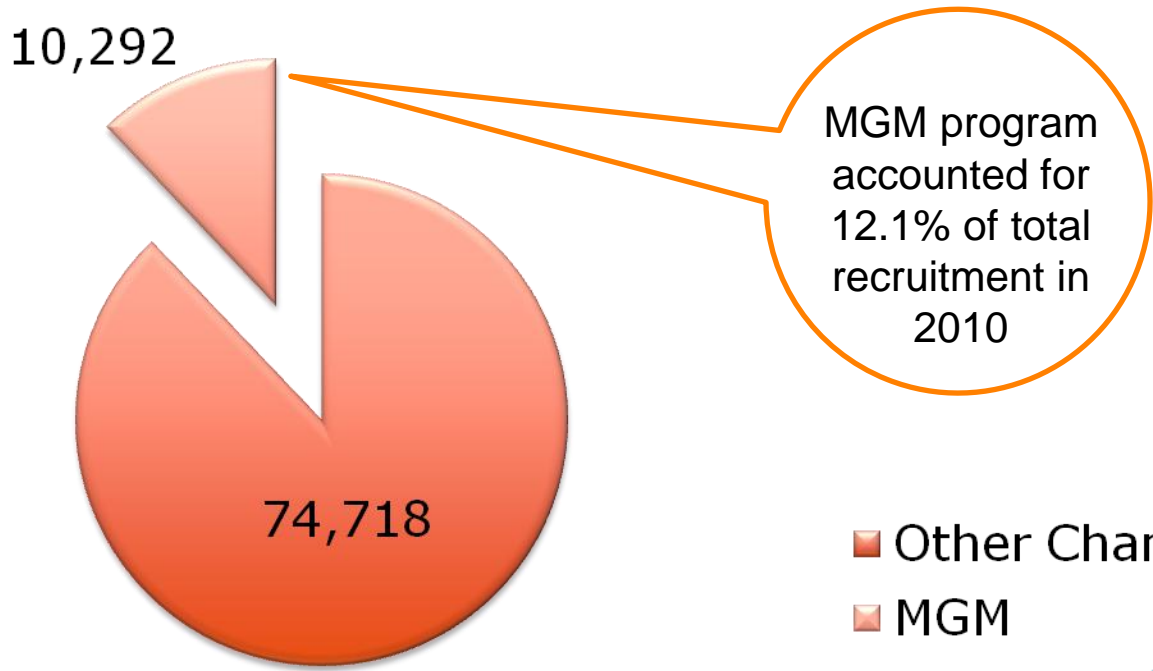
Membership Year

 - 1,501 (47%) student member recruiters
 - 1,694 (53%) higher grade recruiters
 - An average of 3.2 new members per recruiter.
- 10,292 new members were recruited.
 - 8,114 students (79%)
 - 2,178 higher grade (21%)



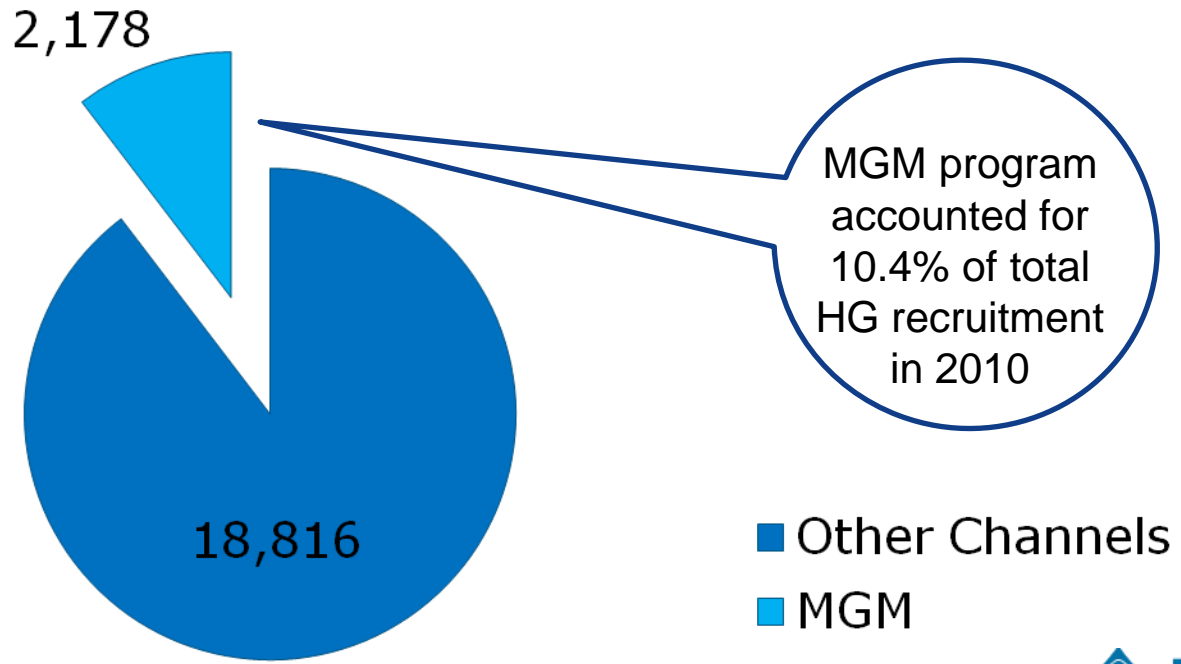
MGM 2010 – Contribution to Overall Recruitment

2010 Total Recruitment



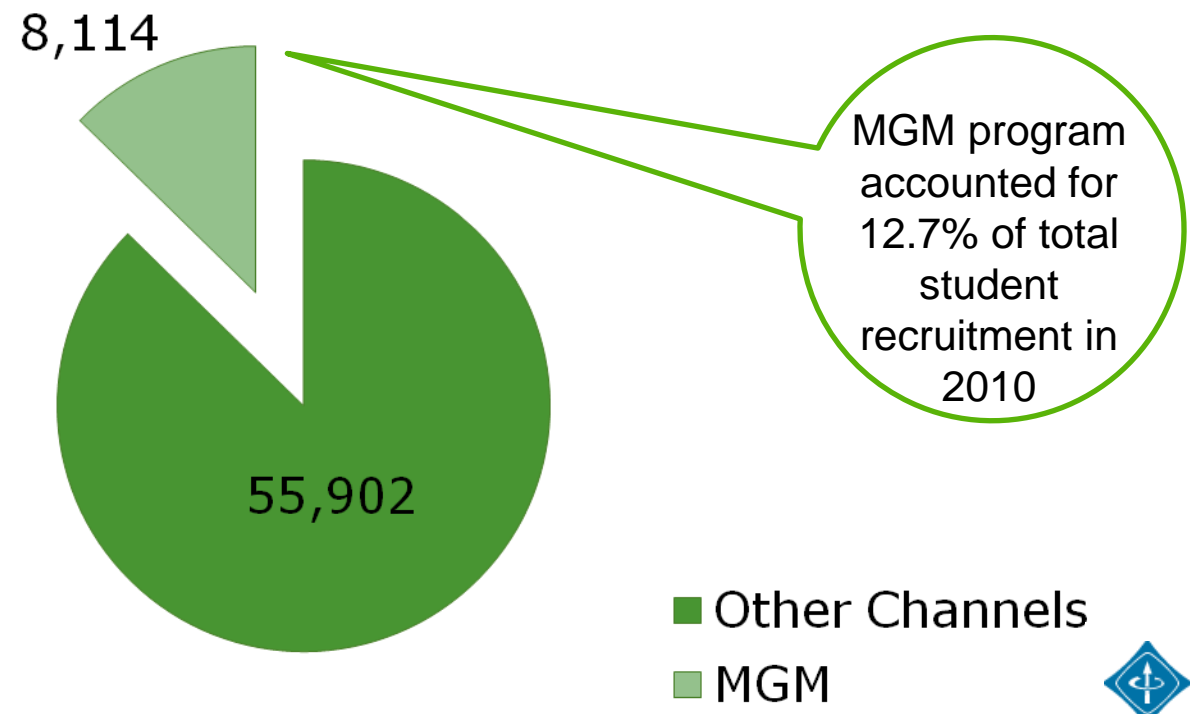
MGM 2010 – Contribution to Overall Recruitment

- YOY average decline was -2.3%
- Regions 3 and 5 have seen growth two years in a row
- Region 9 saw a marked improvement over last year



MGM Recruiters – 2008-2010

- In 2010 we saw the continuation of the trend that more members are recruiting, but recruiting fewer members.
 - Though a smaller increase YOY this year, due to a decrease in STU recruiters
 - Note a marked increase in HG recruiters

MGM 2010 – Overview

- Once again we see a decrease in overall MGM recruitment year-over-year, but an increase in the number of recruiter members participating.
 - Awareness of the program continues to increase, especially among higher grade members.
 - The number of STU recruiters actually decreased.
- Retention rates of recruiters versus recruitees further support that the MGM program is more of a retention tool for HG members (the recruiters), and more of a recruitment tool for STU members.
 - Though only 25% of recruiters in 2009 actually redeemed their awards.
 - *See appendix.*



MGM Program – Updates for 2011

- Implemented a referral award for recruiting e-Membership.
 - Members will earn \$5 per e-Member recruited.
 - It will be of interest to see how this impacts MGM participation.
- New Section award rule
 - Only those recruiters that reach the \$90 maximum award level will be considered for the Section awards (top 5 in each region).
- New reporting on retention rates of recruiters and recruitees will help guide further changes to the program.

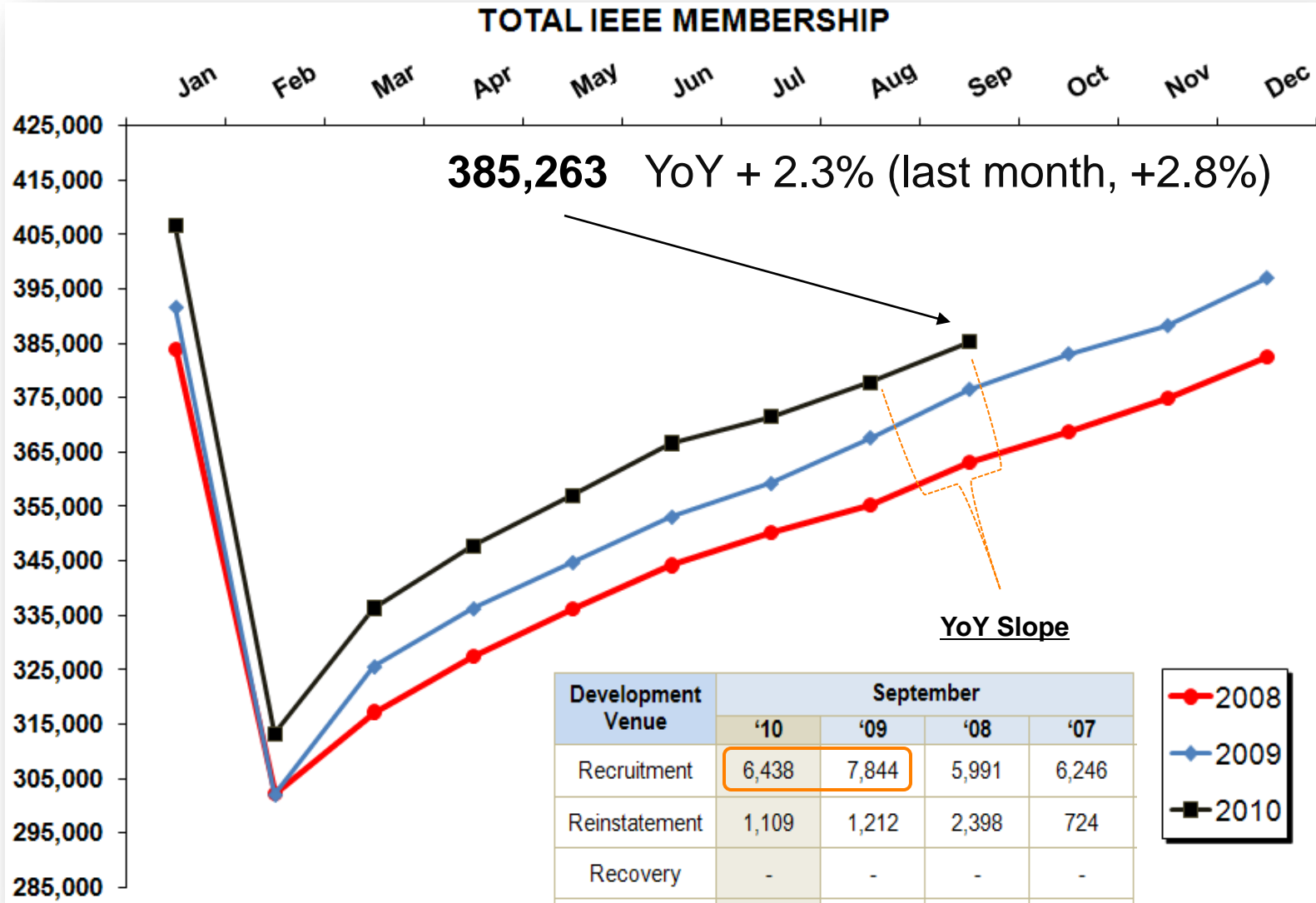

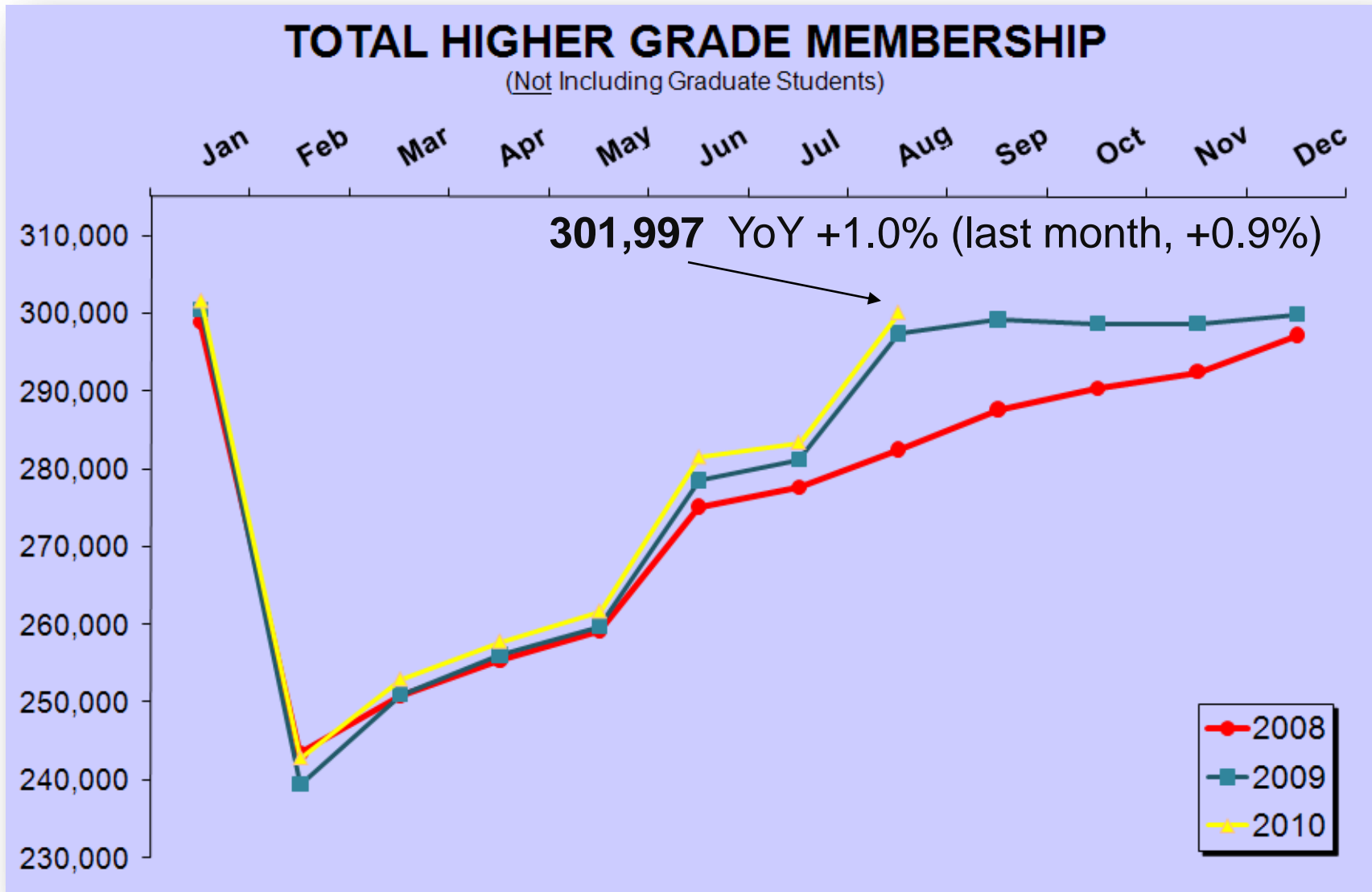
Year-over-Year Monthly Growth – Total Membership



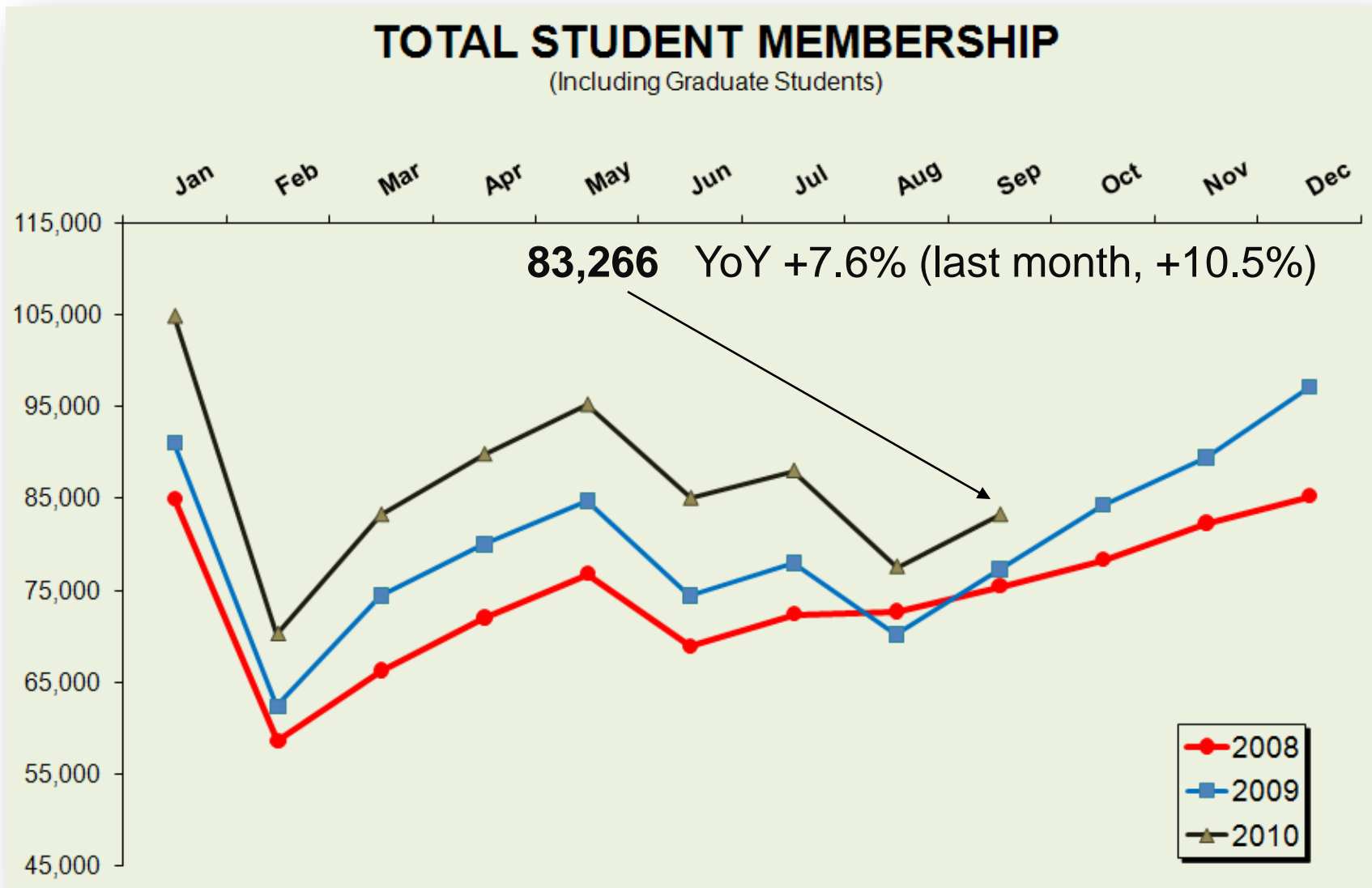

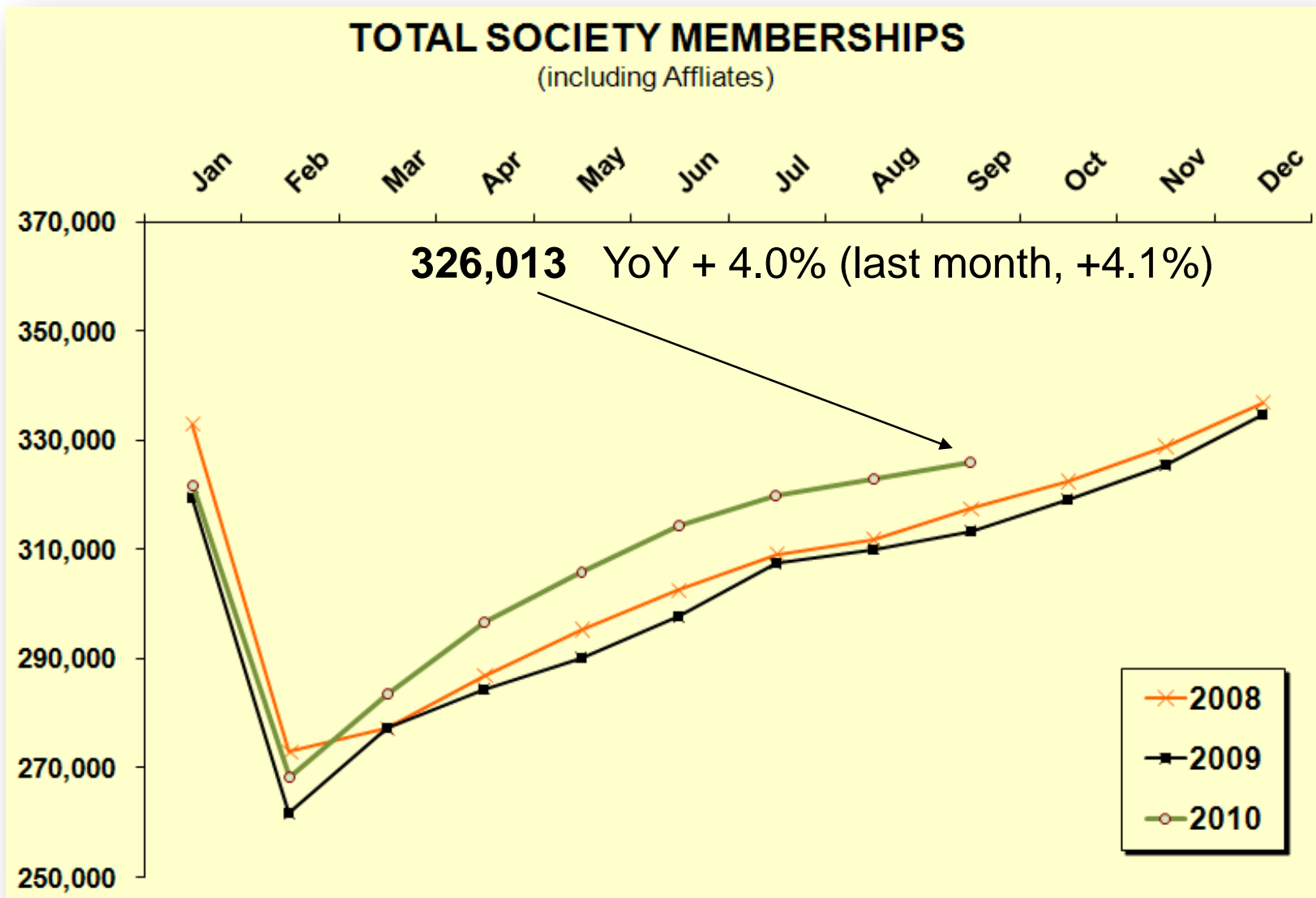

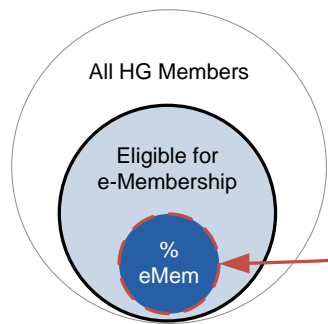
