Candidate Names and Details (biography, reasons for running, etc.)

IEEE Orlando Section Chair, 2025 - Masood Ejaz: Masood Ejaz is a senior member of IEEE and a member of the IEEE HKN and Signal Processing societies, currently serving as chair of the IEEE Orlando section. Previously, he was Vice Chair of the section from 2022 to 2023 and have been the Counselor for the IEEE Valencia College student chapter since 2014. He actively volunteers in STEM, judging events like the Dr. Nelson Ying Orange County Science Exposition and local high school science fairs. Since 2020, he has also served as an ABET Program Evaluator. Professionally, he chairs the B.S. Electrical and Computer Engineering Technology program at Valencia College in Orlando, FL. His goal as chair of the IEEE Orlando section is to organize technical and non-technical events, revive dormant societies, and foster collaboration between the IEEE student branches at UCF and Valencia. If elected for another term, he will continue to promote STEM activities within the section.

IEEE Orlando Section Vice Chair, 2025 – Sonali Das: Sonali Das is working as a Lecturer in the Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering at UCF. She started her journey of teaching at UCF as a Visiting Instructor (Spring 2020), transitioning to a part-time adjunct faculty (Fall 2021) and to the present position in Fall 2023. IEEE Orlando Section Treasurer, 2025 - Joe Juisai: Joe Juisai has been an IEEE Senior Member since 2012 and has served as Treasurer of the IEEE Orlando Section in 2003, 2022, 2023, and 2024, as well as Treasurer of the IEEE Florida Council in 2007.
