C. Old Business

- a. The Tour of Davis-Besse occurred on October 20th.
 - i Bob Toth has been reimbursed for the catering expenses associated with the tour.
 - i. Request to be sent out to members for pictures of the Davis-Besse tour
 - 1. Due to concern for possible security issues it was decided that pictures of the event will not be posted on the website.
- b. "Years of Service" award pins.
 - 1. The pins have not yet arrived. Jarrad Henson will follow up with IEEE.
- c. Dominic Wilson has updated Advisor and student officer names in vTools.
- a. Google apps for OUs
 - i Brandon reported he has been in communication with Mike Fallenstein and is awaiting a response.
 - ii Dominic Wilson will follow further.
 - iii Some reports have already been placed on the "Toledo drive".
- d. Tech Toledo Holiday mixer
 - i. Dominic Wilson attended. There were upwards of 80 individuals at the event; most of them directly associated with IT-themed positions.

- e. Women in Engineering (WIE) international leadership conference, May 22-23, 2017 in San Jose, CA. Jessica Bollin-Smith has interest and has applied for a grant to attend. She has not received a response yet.
 - i. Jessica Bollin-Smith indicated that she is involved with an event taking place in Sylvania, OH on January 14, 2017. She is looking for volunteers to assist.
- f. IEEE PES 2017 PowerAfrica Conference, that will be held in Accra, Ghana from June 27 to 30, 2017

Richard Molyet motioned that the Toledo section contribute \$1000.00 towards the cost of the event and request PACE for \$500.00 reimbursement; Steve Root seconded; the motion was approved unanimously.
