
What you need to do.....

eNotice – Creation

Select "Create eNotice"

There are two types of eNotice. They are eNotice **Express** and regular eNotice. eNotice Express is automatic, has no delay, and does not require IEEE staff time. **Regular eNotice** has a 2 to 5 day delay and requires staff time to send out.



eNotice Features

Advanced User Functions

- Automatically populate "to" list from IEEE Membership Database
 - Manages member contact flags
- Allow for reminder Emails to be automatically sent out
- Can have your email as "from"
- Can have your email address as "reply to"
- Can include send date
- Can include attachments
- Can request special actions by IEEE staff
 - Special searches



Chapter Elections

- Chapter officers: Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary, Treasurer
- Chapter officers must be Graduate Student, Member, Senior Member, or Fellow
- Chapter officers serve on Calendar year basis
- Chapter officer terms are one year for 2018 per Section Committee. Section Executive Committee will decide on later years.
- Chapter officers are limited to four consecutive years and six years total







 - Top level filtering on Region, Grade and IEEE Status.
- There are two dashboard tabs available:
 - Tab 1 contains the actual Dashboard
 - Tab 2 contains the individual member data
- Available Data:
 - Student Counts by Section/School, Member Grade, Gender, Field of Study
 - "Student" view students attending school outside your Section, but reside there



Dashboard 3: Volunteer Positions

- There are two tabs and 1 link:
 - Tab 1 lists "all" current IEEE volunteer positions.
 - Tab 2 contains views by OU Type and Name for all related volunteer positions
 - The link lists all "past" volunteer positions recorded in the IEEE database.
- Available Data:
 - Volunteer Count by Gender
 - Positions Vacant or Filled





Dashboard 4: Memberships, Subscriptions, and More

Main dashboard for chapter officers to member contact data



- This Dashboard provides information for:
 - Other IEEE memberships
 - IEEE Subscriptions and participations
 - By region, grade, gender, years of service, and renewal category.
- Society, Council, Community, Chapter and Affinity Group users access information for their specific group using filter
- There are five (5) tab options available:
 - Product Dashboard
 - Product Summary by Region by Grade
 - Renewal Category Dashboard
 - Renewal Summary by Region by Grade
 - Detail



Dashboard 5: Doublet

For advanced users

- This dashboard only contains one view.
- Provides counts of overlapping memberships between:
 - IEEE memberships
 - Society memberships
 - IEEE Affinity Groups
 - Standards Association membership
- The table uses two filters:
 - Primary Membership(s)
 - Secondary Membership(s)





What is the GDPR?

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

- Intended to strengthen and unify data protection for all European Union (EU) citizens and individuals within the EU
- Instituted by the European Parliament, the Council of the European Union, and the European Commission
- The GDPR's primary aim is to give control back to citizens and residents over their personal data.
- Because of its extraterritorial aspects, international businesses will be impacted by the regulation

GDPR Went into effect 25 May 2018



Who Does the GDPR Apply To?

GDPR applies to organizations:

- Established in the EU or
- Process the personal data of EU individuals, whether or not the organization was established in the EU
- IEEE meets these qualifications and is subject to GDPR
- GDPR protects the personal data of individuals. Examples include:
 - Name
 - Photo
 - Email address
 - IP address



Why is Compliance Important?

- Organizations can be fined up to 4% of annual global turnover* for breaching the GDPR or €20 Million, whichever is higher.
 - This is the maximum fine that can be imposed for the most serious infringements
 - e.g., deliberate violations, not having sufficient customer consent to process data, or violating the core of Privacy by Design concepts.
- Regulatory agencies may also be permitted to enforce other penalties such as deletion of personal data and placing limitations on interactions with citizen of EU member states.
- Individuals can be held personally liable if the data access and use policy is in place, but is blatantly disregarded

- ALL IEEE volunteers must become knowledgeable on how to comply with the regulation
- If you are not using vTools eNotice, consider making the switch for your email communications.
 - eNotice will automatically apply all the necessary communication preferences thereby keeping you compliant with GDPR.
- If you are using ListServ, insure your list is managed, has a welcome message, and the opt-out text at the bottom of every Email.
- Take the time to delete any old member lists you may have stored locally.




