Siri called the meeting to order at 12:10 PM. The meeting minutes from 10/14/2004 were reviewed and approved.

### Review of Previous Action Items

### Old Business Updates

- ***2004 Short Course (Congestion Management):*** The Short Course on October 16 was a success. A profit of roughly \$300 is expected, although several hundred dollars have not yet been received. Surveys were distributed at the course, and 20 responses were received. Based on a scoring range of 1 (bad) to 5 (good), the average response score was **4.7!!** Low scores were only found in two areas. One was regarding a speaker that attendees felt was underqualified. ADCOM discussed the need to check the qualifications of speakers more carefully in the future. The other low scores were in regards to the food provided. ADCOM discussed the need to more closely coordinate with the SF State student chapter on the food expectations and specifications next time, or evaluate other catering options or locations. The IEEE GRID advertising was generally agreed to have not been very effective and ADCOM should consider not spending \$600 on a full-blown GRID advertisement for the next Short Course. Many thanks to Shimo and all others who worked on this event.
- ***High Performance Chapter Award (HPCA):*** Siri asked each ADCOM member responsible for a category of activities, as specified on the attached schedule, *to send him information about this year's activities in that area* for use in the HPCA application.
- ***Elections for 2005 ADCOM Officers:*** As reported last month, the officers nominated for 2005 are: President – Chuck Magee; Vice President – Bhaskar Ray; Treasurer – Ben Williams; Secretary – Shirin Tabatabai. Siri asked these individuals to *send him biographical information and a picture as soon as possible.*

## New Business

- ***IEEE PES ADCOM Appreciation Lunch:*** Siri announced a holiday appreciation lunch for all ADCOM members. ADCOM members voted to hold a lunch rather than a dinner. The lunch will be planned for **December 21, 2004** at the **Atrium**; mark your calendars!!
- ***SF IEEE PES 2005 Summer Meeting:*** This meeting will be held in San Francisco at the Hilton (Union Square). IEEE is eager to get support from ADCOM. Four SF PES and one OEB PES members met with meeting organizers on October 27 to discuss meeting preparations. Meeting organizers indicated that they will need 8-10 committee chairpersons leading the roughly 100 volunteers needed to pull off the event. No corporate sponsor has been identified as of yet for this event; organizers indicated that they would attempt to contact PG&E. ADCOM members are still awaiting an email follow-up to the meeting that was promised, but will proactively attempt to contact volunteer organizers to get the latest status.
- ***Future Technical Meeting Topics:***
  - Fuel cells: The “Future Car” PBS video was obtained by Chuck and screened by Julian. Since one more technical presentation is needed to qualify for the HPCA, this event will be scheduled for December 1. *Chuck will develop a flier and make arrangements.*
  - Substation Design Automation: Speaker and date still unscheduled. This meeting will be scheduled for 2005. (**Kris**)
