



ExCom Meeting Minutes – January 7, 2009

Held at Cogswell College, Sunnyvale, CA

Attendance: 19 – *See attached attendance list.*

Section Chair Roxsana Hadjizadeh called the meeting to order at 6:08 PM

Agenda

- Agenda approved without changes.
- Last meeting minutes of Dec 3, 2008 rev. 2 were approved without changes.
- Introduction of 2009 new board members:
 - Attendees introduced themselves starting with Roxsana as the new Chair and moving counterclockwise, ended with Dr. Hamid Berenji.

Chapter Reports from December

- **Computational Intelligence Society (CIS)**
 - Dr. Hamid Berenji presented the CIS chapter report.
 - Two chapter meetings occurred in 2008.
 - There are 90 members, and CIS has a bank account of \$500.
 - Problems with the CIS bank account were discovered and resolved last month.
 - Volunteers will help in the Short Course planned for 2009. Roxsana mentioned that the CIS Chapter can present the Short Course Budget at a future ExCom meeting and if necessary, obtain seed money for it.

Officer Reports

- **Chair Reports – Roxsana Hadjizadeh**
 - Opening remarks – Roxsana Hadjizadeh – *see attached report.*
 - SFBAC Rep (two reps) – Ram Sivaraman and Tom Coughlin.
 - SFBAC Treasurer: It is SCV's turn to replace the past Treasurer Dan Sparks. Allen Earman will become Treasurer for 2009.
 - IEEE 125th anniversary celebration – scheduled for early Fall 2009 – Tom Coughlin / Ram Sivaraman
 - IEEE Headquarters will be paying for this event.
 - Dates: undecided (probably between mid-Sept to early Oct. 2009)
 - SCV Section is the largest IEEE Section worldwide
 - Officer's training – 2009 – Scheduled for Jan 24th at Michael's at Shoreline – Min Hua already mailed invitations to Chapter officers of the SCV Section.
 - SVEC Engineers Banquet – John Gale was not present
 - It was moved by David Craven and seconded by Allen Earman that the SCV Section will sponsor 4 tables (40 attendees), at a total cost of \$3,000 for the SVEC Engineers Banquet. The event date will be February 19,



2009. The location will be the San Jose Doubletree Hotel. There was a lively discussion and the motion was approved unanimously at 7:10 PM. The attendees will be from the government and the press. Dan Oprica will coordinate the attendance of chapter officers and section officers. A check for \$3,000 was written to Dan for the 4 tables. Another check was written for \$2,000 to be used for two \$1,000 / each scholarships. Government guests will be recommended by the CPMT chapter and invitations will be written by Roxsana. ExCom members are invited on a first come, first serve basis. Spouses will be waitlisted.

- Action Item for the SCV Secretary
 - A list of Chapter and Section Officers should be e-mailed to the SCV Chair to use for invitations.

- **Vice Chair Report – Allen Earman**
 - Three chapters have not yet requested their rebate checks. Interest rates went down from 3.5% to 2.65%.

- **Secretary Report – Mohamed Sayed**
 - Mohamed presented a draft template for **Annual Chapter Reports** (*attached*). PowerPoint slides can be used by presenters in addition to filling out the report template. A draft template for **Committee Chair Reports** was also presented (*attached*). Mohamed requested that these reports be completed and e-mailed back to him and Roxsana prior to each monthly ExCom meeting.

- **Treasurer Report – Mark Hooper**
 - Current Financials – Mark presented the report with Allen's help. The end of the year surplus was \$10,738 from revenue, and \$17,994 from expenses. Thus the total surplus was \$28,733.
 - 2008 L50 – L50 Reports need to be completed and sent to Mark before January 31, 2009.
 - Rebate status – All but 3 rebate checks were given to chapters.

- **PACE Chair** – Ram Sivaraman mentioned that a technical talk will be given at Cadence Design Systems in San Jose in April 2009. Ram will assist engineers who are looking for jobs. Linked-In for IEEE-SCV will be completed by March 2009.

Part II will be held on Friday, May 8th. This will be the main event. The speaker is confirmed for a one hour talk before going the tour of the *Tech Museum of Innovation* in San Jose.
