- ▶ 11 13 August 2017
- Registration Fee for Primary Section Delegate (PSD) will be waived
 - Registration codes are available
 - Must provide name of PSD to Sean Haynes (s.a.haynes@ieee.org) to receive
- PSD Hotel for 4 nights will be reimbursed
 - 10 Aug through 14 Aug
- PSD Meals outside of conference will be reimbursed (up to US\$200)
- Lowest Fare Coach airfare for dates of conference will be reimbursed
 - Upgraded fare reimbursement requests must include a printout of lowest fare coach airfare
 - Extended stay airfare reimbursement request must include a printout of lowest fare coach for dates of conference
 - Depart 8 Aug for 10 Aug arrival return 14 Aug
 - Discount codes for airlines will be provided (Delta, United, Qantas)

Registration and Hotel

Reimbursement

- All expenses for PSD will be reimbursed by MGA
 - Only airfare maybe submitted early for reimbursement prior to the conference
 - Expense reports must be submitted in PDF format to Sean Haynes (<u>s.a.haynes@ieee.org</u>)
 - Only lowest available coach airfare at the time of reservation will be reimbursed
 - For flights departing 8 Aug to arrive on 10 Aug and returning on 14 Aug
 - All other expenses (meals, hotel, visa, etc.) will be reimbursed post-conference
- All other attendees will be reimbursed via their sponsoring entity.

Recommendation Process

- Recommendations will be developed at SoutheastCon 2017 in Charlotte



SoutheastCon Recommendation Process

Overview

- Each Area/Council will develop at most 3 recommendations during their Area/Council meetings at SoutheastCon
- ► These recommendations MUST focus in one of the following areas and note how they will improve IEEE's ability to perform in these areas:
 - Networking
 - Skills Improvement
 - Public Service
- ▶ A Champion should be identified for each of the Area/Council's recommendation
- The Champion will present the recommendation at the Region 3 meeting on Saturday
- ▶ The Region 3 Committee will vote for the top 3 recommendations on Sunday
 - Each committee member will get 3 votes
 - The top 3 vote getting recommendations will be sent IEEE MGA for presentation at Sections Congress
