Successes/Opportunities for Engaging the member, volunteer, nonmember, public

- The Richmond Section participated in a local Celebrate Engineering Ingenuity Day event that is designed to introduce elementary through high school students to engineering. IEEE members helped students assemble a small circuit board in the shape of a cat face. The board has series and parallel resistors plus a 555 timer circuit that allowed the students to change what the cat's eyes look like. The board was designed by our Young Professionals Affinity Group and the Richmond Section covered the cost of the boards and parts so that the participants could take home their completed board at no cost. The event was well attended. Participants were also introduced to the tryengineering.org website that the IEEE has set up to introduce children and their teachers to engineering.
- Individualized emails were sent out to IEEE members in our Section who had not renewed yet
 - reminding them if they had simply forgotten to renew;
 - telling them about reduced fee memberships if they were having financial or unemployment problems, and;

• asking for feedback if they had decided not to renew because we did not meet their needs. Reminders for Life and Life Senior Members were sent by a Life Senior Member.
