Next Region 3 Committee webex will be 17 August, 8-10 pm eastern

Can you believe it's almost August? I hope you all are finding some safe but fun ways to enjoy the summer! There are many things to cover here; I'll try to just hit the highlights.

At our ExCom meeting on Monday, the N&A committee will discuss the Region 3 Director-Elect 2022-2023 candidate slate, in Executive Session. This will be done at the end of the meeting; only voting members of the ExCom will stay on for the discussion and vote. The ExCom will vote on the slate that will be sent forward to the Region 3 Committee in August for approval.

A very important Region 3 Committee Meeting will be held via webex on Monday, Aug 17, 8-10 pm eastern. **ExCom and Committee members are all urged to attend. The voting R3 Committee members will be considering / approving the Region 3 Director-Elect 2022-2023 candidate slate, so we need all Committee members to attend. Section Chairs – you are voting members of the R3 Committee!** I anticipate also having a talk by IEEE Entrepreneurship, a discussion about using vTools for voting, and a demo of the upcoming new R3 website, among other things.

Before the Region 3 Committee meeting, I will provide a form for each Section to submit about their plans for a New Event. Area Chairs – please reach out to your Sections to see how they are coming along with their plans! I am hopeful that most Sections can find a way to hold a new event in 2020, but even if it will be pushed to 2021, I want to hear about your plans!

IEEE membership is down 5.8%. While that is mostly due to students, higher grade membership is down 2.5%. For Region 3, higher grade membership is down 4%. While that is the smallest loss in the US, we of course would prefer to be gaining instead of losing! Let's continue working on finding virtual ways to engage – and don't forget to invite non-members that attend events to join IEEE.

IEEE-Eta Kappa Nu (IEEE-HKN), the honor society of IEEE, encourages and recognizes individual excellence in education and meritorious work, in professional practice, and in any of the areas within the IEEE-designated fields of interest. One of the things we missed out on at SoutheastCon was an HKN Induction Ceremony. I've asked HKN to do a live webinar for us on **Wednesday, Aug 19 at 8pm (ET)**. They will first talk with us about HKN and how Sections and individuals can be involved, and will then have the Induction Ceremony of the Professional Members. We are setting this up so each Section, if they would like to do so, can offer this as a virtual Section meeting. We will be sending out information about that soon. For others, you can join as part of the Region. I've talked with IEEE-

Standards Association about also doing a Wednesday night meeting for us, but don't yet have a firm commitment from them.

Quick Bits:

- Sections Congress info will be provided at the ExCom meeting
- OU Analytics is now available for Life Member Groups
- Vtools events have increased by almost 50% -- go find a meeting anywhere in the world that you want to attend!
- IEEE Day is October 6 (more info at ExCom meeting)
- R3 Bylaws changes were approved by MGA
- Concur will roll-out to Sections in Q3 of this year. Concentration Banking accounts will be set up for those Sections that don't currently have one, for processing Concur payments
- Look at the bottom of the MGA Scoop newsletter for resources for volunteers!
- MGA is reviewing the requirements for Geographic Councils. If you are in a Council, they may reach out to you with some questions.
- Conferences that have gone virtual with time have had a large increase in attendance
- When using R3 mailing lists, make sure it is for R3 business
- IEEE-USA has several recorded webinars that could be used for a virtual section meeting, and offer PDHs! You could play one as a Section meeting, with a discussion afterward. <https://ieeusa.org/careers/webinars/>
- The Region 3 mentoring program is kicking-off! Program manager is Kristen Parrish.
- We hope to have the R3 YouTube channel(s) up and running soon; consider using the content for a virtual meeting.
