Guidelines

 - Deliver technology ideas to teachers for virtual technology experiments
 - Assist elderly with virtual networking
 - Many other possible problems/solutions
- Problem / Solution must align with the IEEE Fields of Interest
- Should include section members / chapters / community
- Deadline for submissions: 12/15/2020
- Projects reviewed, winners notified, and funds transferred: 12/31/2020
