Region 3 membership in July 22 was up 1.7% over last year, with a total membership of 22,553. Grad students are up 10%, Undergrad students are up 24.1%, but Higher Grade members were down 0.4%. We have the second largest growth of the six US Regions. (Region 5 beat us this month.)

June Board Series went well, and the board endorsed an [amendment to the IEEE Constitution](#) that increases the total number of voting members required to add a member-initiated petition to the annual ballot from 0.333% to 1% and add a 0.333% voting member requirement for each Region.
