Committee Responsibilities

- Publicize Region 3 and other IEEE awards
- Encourage Sections to nominate qualified members
- Present proposed award recipients to the Region 3 ExCom
- Provide awardee information to Region 3 Director
- Support Region 3 Member Activities
 Committee in maximizing media exposure

- Provide information on awards to SoutheastCon General Chair
- Ensure the Awards Ceremony runs smoothly
- Keep current documentation on Region awards and overall management of the awards operation in the Region
- Manage awards budget and submit preliminary budget prior to fall Region 3 ExCom meeting
- Actively encourage Sections and Chapters to recognize the members

Region 3 Professional Awards (as of September 2022)

Daniel W. Jackson Award

Purpose: To recognize a <u>Past Director</u> who, through continuing service to the Region and to the Institute, has made exemplary contributions to the electrotechnology profession.

Joseph M. Biedenbach Outstanding Engineering Educator Award

Purpose: To recognize a member of Region 3 who has shared technical and professional abilities through <u>teaching</u> in industry, government, or in an institution of higher learning and in so doing has made an outstanding contribution to the electrotechnology profession.

Region 3 Outstanding Engineer Award

Purpose: To recognize a member of Region 3 who, through <u>technical</u> and professional abilities, has made an outstanding contribution to the electrotechnology profession.



Region 3 Professional Awards (as of September 2022)

Region 3 Outstanding Service Award

To recognize a member of Region 3 who, through service to the <u>Region</u> and the Institute, has made an outstanding contribution to the electrotechnology profession.

Professional Leadership Award

Purpose: To recognize a member of Region 3 for outstanding leadership efforts in achieving the <u>professional</u> [economic, ethical, legislative, social] aims of IEEE in the United States.

Employer Professional Development Award

Purpose: To recognize an employer in Region 3 for outstanding contributions in advancing the <u>professional development</u> of employees.



Region 3 Professional Awards (as of September 2022)

Young Professional Award

To promote, recognize and support contributions from <u>young professional</u> members within IEEE Region 3. This award recognizes <u>leadership</u> in service, education, innovation, entrepreneurship or in furthering the goals of the IEEE Young Professionals.

Educational Activities Chair Award – new award for 2022

To promote and recognize leadership in service, education, innovation, entrepreneurship or in furthering the goals of the IEEE Educational Activities in Sections. Eligible candidates must be IEEE Sections' Education Activity Committee Chairs (or equivalent role) in Region 3 at the time of the nomination deadline.



Region 3 Awards Site

- Region 3 now uses Open Water for awards nominations

- May use IEEE credentials to log on
- Fill in requested information; you will receive an email confirmation
 - Make sure you include endorsements!
 - Incomplete nominations will not be reviewed
- Start early!
 - Familiarize with awards website
 - Gather information on candidate
 - Get two endorsement letters cannot be nominator or nominee
 - Allow time for "features" of website
